#### FELLOWSHIP (Nancy Hamilton): Church dinners, caregiving meals, PW

Church wide picnic Sept 13th @ Idlewild Park (Found out there is no vacancy for this date at the park. May have to reschedule the date

#### BUILDING & GROUNDS (Jerry Cole): Lawn care, equipment, maintenance, cleaning service

(1) Outdoor posts have been redone and are ready for signage; (2) florescent fixtures need to be replaced in various areas of church. Last year's price to replace all of them was \$3300. Motion to approve monies for replacement but to be dispersed in increments was made by Tom Clifford, seconded by Tricia Bunn; all approved. (3) The cleaning service will charge \$150 for disinfection. If there is a positive case of COVID-10 the cost is \$500. (4) Skip Smith is checking on the possibility of purchasing an air sprayer for disinfecting. (5) All mowers are in working order.

#### WORSHIP & EDUCATION (Kathy Jones): Nursery, Special Offerings, Sunday School, Liturgical supplies

(1) When worship service begins there will be 2 children. Both will be in the nursery. (2) On July 25 several volunteers will meet at the church to do a final disinfection prior to worship on the 26th. (3) After making phone calls, it is felt that around 20 members will be here for worship on the 26th. (4) PW will meet on Monday, Aug 24 for their first meeting of the new church year.

#### MISSION AND OUTREACH (Sharon Browning): publicity and advertising, website, ASP, girl scouts

#### ADMINISTRATIVE (Tricia Bunn): Stewardship, personnel, volunteer scheduling

OLD BUSINESS: Nominating Committee Report: The two new members of the Class of 2023 will be Travis Meredith and Peter Bonney. Pastor Peter Kim will meet with them in the near future. These new officers will come on board Sunday, September 13.

NEW BUSINESS: (1) It is felt that the church needs to purchase a laptop and a Pandora premium account so that various music can be played during the worship services. Motion was made by Tom Clifford, seconded by Kathy Jones that MSPC submit an application to the Presbytery for a Pharr grant that would pay for the laptop, the Pandora account and any accessory items for the safety and security of the equipment; all approved. Tom will contact Peter Bonney regarding the type of laptop that will be needed. (2) The phone system for the church is very antiquated. Barbara Smith has gotten some figures from Windstream to upgrade the system. There will be a one-time fee of \$480 and the monthly bundled fee will be around \$230, which is presently \$195. Motion that MSPC have its phone equipment upgraded was made by Tom Clifford, seconded by Jerry Cole and all approved.

Request for Facility Usage: Lisa Jillani has requested to use the fellowship and kitchen area of MSPC for a day long meeting (8am-6pm) of the Foundation for Applied Conservative Leadership. She used our facility in June with no issues. Motion than Lisa Jillani rent MSPC for \$350 on Saturday August 22<sup>nd</sup> was made by Sharon Browning, seconded by Tricia Bunn and all approved.





## WALKING

"When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said. "I am God Almighty: walk before me faithfully and be blameless." (Genesis 17:3)

"[B]ut those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow wearv. they will walk and not be faint." (Isaiah 40:31)

Many of you know by now (reading from July's Newsletter) that I am an "exercise-holic." (I don't think it's even a word.) I love to exercise. I will choose to exercise over sleep. I will choose to exercise over food. You can ask my family, and they will tell you the same. So, when the gym closed due the Pandemic in March, I was reduced to walking every day. In the beginning (starting in March), walking 3.5 miles in the morning and 3.5 miles in the evening seemed easy. I did it effortlessly...really. This lasted approximately four months.

But recently (starting in July), my walking became tedious and laborious. And it dawned on me one day as I was walking, how difficult it was to faithfully walk every In His Firm Grip, day. First, it was time consuming. Second, it was downright boring! And third, it was monotonous! I didn't want Peter to do the "same ole, same ole" anymore!

The "same ole, same ole." This is how many of us might be feeling today during this Pandemic. How do I stay faithful? How do I faithfully walk with Jesus when everything seems monotonous and tedious? We've done the

same things over and over. We wake up. Eat breakfast. Stay home. Work (if we are still working.) Eat lunch. Do chores around the house. Eat dinner. Clean up. Wash up. Go to bed. And do it all over again.

This is when we (you and I) need to heed God's Word from Genesis 17:1 and Isaiah 40:31!

Despite our current circumstances and situations, we need to walk faithfully before our God AND be blameless. This is not easy. Trust me. It's not easy!

It's tempting to want to soar on wings like eagles. We all want to fly. Many of us would even rather run and "just get it over with" whatever we are doing. We want to see the end to all this "craziness." We want to quickly cross the finish line. But I wonder how many of us are willing to walk AND not grow weary and not be faint!

You see, walking is not for the faint-hearted. It takes stamina to walk daily. It takes commitment to walk daily. It takes faith to walk daily with God. Despite the uncertainties of life, there is one thing that is certain — and that is, our God is Holy, Sovereign, loving and merciful. And He calls us to walk with Him faithfully and blamelessly, and not grow weary and not be faint.




From Your Your TCaM Team of the Charlotte Presbytery:
