"Ph.D."

I will never forget a conversation I had with my dad when I was a first year student at Princeton Theological Seminary.

I asked my dad, "So, what do you think about my pursuing a Ph.D. degree?" Being a former professor himself. I thought he would be thrilled.

But to my dismay, he was upset and disappointed! He was downright angry! With his stern voice, he said, "Son, you are called to be a pastor to shepherd God's people. You need to focus on ministry and not on degrees and titles."

That one conversation has since reminded of me of my greatest calling- calling to pastor God's people. No matter what happens, I will always be a pastor! I will always be His servant. And that calling will never change.

However, some things have changed in my life. Despite my dad's stern rebuke, I have finally received my "Ph.D." Or should I say more accurately, I have "become" a "Ph.D.!"

By God's grace I am a "Ph.D.!" On April 26, 1998 in Raleigh, North Carolina, I was ordained as a Minister of the Word and Sacrament. Thus, I received my "P" and officially became a pastor.

I continued to pursue my "Ph.D." On February 19, 2000 when my wife walked down the aisle at a church in Michigan, and said, "I do" to me, I earned my "H" and became a husband.

And on April 2, 2002, I earned my "D" when I became a proud **dad** to our first son, Ethan, thus, I finally earned my "Ph.D."

So, with or without a "real" degree or title, I have earned my true "Ph.D." I am and will always be a Pastor, Husband, and Dad.

Remember my friends, degrees and titles aren't everything! They might be something. And they have some value, but they aren't everything!

"Be warned, my son [my daughter], of anything in addition to them. Of making [studying] many books there is no end, and much study wearies the body." (Ecclesiastes 12:12) (Really...this verse is from the Bible.)
