Nikki read minutes from the 6/2/22 meeting. Gilbert motioned to accept, Steve seconded.


Matt was absent, treasurers report was not given

Old Business: School District 1 Board meeting this week. Rosalie and Gilbert attended. Rosalie engaged in arguments against the sex education curriculum. It teaches abstinence and yet discusses various ways people can show affection and how to act it out. They advocate ways to abstain from having sex is to engage in anal and oral sex. Keith Ware (board member) made a motion to rescind the curriculum and it was voted on 4-1. Barbara Foote voted to retain the program. It stands rescinded for now. Rosalie mentioned that the Yuma County Health Dept authorized this program and it is backed by the Soros group. New Business:

Karrin Taylor Robson, candidate AZ Governor will have a meet and greet at Lukes Casino on June 30th from 3-4 PM.

Carol Smith, candidate for Yuma City Council spoke about why she is running for city council. Carol has Yuma family roots and has worked as a Neo Natal Nurse at YRMC for 11 years. She is currently a nurse educator at the hospital leading a team of 50 nurses. Her number one priority is funding public safety, the police and fire departments. She supports expanding our education system with a multi university effort and holding our leaders accountable. She exhibits good listening skills and finding out what the needs of the public are and will support what they want.



Henry Venezuela and Morgan Patterson with the Fraternal Order of Police gave an educational and eye-opening reality check on how understaffed and underpaid our local Yuma Police Force is. They indicated that the FOP is not the police department, and they are not speaking on their behalf. There are 272 members consisting of border patrol agents, ADOT, sheriff's deputies and the police dept. The police department is authorized for 167 officers and currently have 121 with 30 vacancies. They lose 7 officers a year which is not sustainable. Yuma ranks 16th in the state for officers pay. Phoenix just gave their officers a \$20 K raise and 7 K sign on bonus. Tempe, Mesa, and Gilbert will match, and Yuma will probably lose more officers for higher pay and benefits. Young police officers want boots on the ground and chasing bad guys for big money. Yuma can't compete. Our officers are training here and leaving. They need an additional \$1,018.053 in funding to stay competitive with other Arizona cities. They also need career enhancement incentives, health insurance and take-home vehicles. Funding needs to be addressed every year. The public can help by contacting their city council members and make sure they are funding the local police and fire departments.

Neil highlighted items on his handout that are worth reading, listening to, and acting on and handed out a sad and sorry scorecard for Senator Mark Kelly.

Howard Blitz with The Freedom Library handed out a flyer for the next class on the U.S. Constitution starting August 16th from 6-8 PM and July 4th 9-10 AM a history and reading of the Declaration of Independence.

Jan 6 committee flouts the rules of Congress, delivers propaganda

The Jan. 6 House Select Committee has been marred by officials acting in an arbitrary and capricious manner. The journalistic result is propaganda not fairly and honestly informing the American people on the conduct of this committee and its threat to democratic government

For example,

"[I]t is well established that, when a congressional committee seeks to use the implied authority to compel testimony, it must respect the Separation of Powers; it must do so only in pursuit of a valid legislative purpose (and not for the purpose of generating publicity or pursuing law enforcement) and it must follow the rules associated with the delegation on which its claimed subpoena authority relies."

This quote appears at page 4 of the Introduction to the reply brief (Case 1:21-cv-03217-CJN Document 38 Filed 06/06/22) filed by former White House Chief of Staff Mark Meadows in his lawsuit against Speaker Nancy Pelosi and the Jan. 6 committee.

The Meadows reply brief opened the Introduction with this statement:

"No authoritative appellate court has ever held that a senior aide to a President, or a President himself, can be compelled by Congress to appear and give testimony, let alone when there is a claim of Executive Privilege."

This statement makes clear how breathtaking Speaker Pelosi's actions have proven to be, willing to dash to pieces the Separation of Powers tradition of our tripartite federal government. As it happened, three days before the Meadows reply brief was filed, June 6, at the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, the Department of Justice chose not to bring contempt of Congress charges against Mr. Meadows and another former Trump aide,



Dan Scavino, although it did bring charges against former Trump aide Peter Navarro.


On June 9, the Jan. 6 committee opened a series of hearings, the first held in prime tv time with scant, if any, media attention to the litigation challenging the very existence of this ironically titled "select committee" for not following the rules that called the panel into existence.

The lead editorial in the June 11/12 edition of The Wall Street Journal, "The Evidence of the Jan. 6 Committee," opened by acknowledging that the committee treated the Republican Party unfairly, but then proceeded to excoriate Donald J. Trump without taking notice of the litigation in federal court challenging the existence of this 'select committee' for not abiding by the rules set forth in H. Res 503 (17th Congress) establishing this committee which The New York Times, acknowledged was more prosecutorial than law-making.

Imagine going to a baseball game. The rules provide that each side gets three outs per inning. Now, imagine, further, that one side is given 6 outs per inning. Should baseball reporters accept this blatant disregard of the rules in covering the game?

H. Res. 503 provided that the Jan. 6 committee would consist of 13 representatives, with five members chosen by the Speaker in consultation with the minority leader. This did not happen. Minority Leader Kevin McCarthy named Representatives Jim Jordan and Jim Banks to the select committee -- and Speaker Pelosi vetoed the minority leaders first two choices.

Accordingly, it would be more accurate to call this the Nancy Pelosi-Selected Jan. 6 House Committee. The Pelosi veto of Jordan and Banks was made even more egregious when the Speaker installed turncoat Republicans Liz Cheney and Adam Kinzinger on the panel. (Cheney cannot be considered ranking member of the panel; ranking members of House committees are selected by the minority leader.). Whatever happened to the notion that no person is above the law? In operating the Jan. 6 House Select Committee, Nancy Pelosi has placed herself above House rules. If her operation of this inquisitorial panel becomes precedent, can there be any doubt that rules in the House become irrelevant? Just name a committee and give the chair the latitude to run the panel arbitrarily and capriciously, and to heck with the norms of democratic government.



Yet, even if leading media outlets come to revise their scrutiny of this rogue committee, its damaging purpose could be attained, should Attorney General Garland follow his Navarro indictment by filing charges against former president Trump in federal court in the District of Columbia. Is it beyond possibility that the action of a partisan, that is to say Democrat, jury in Washington would be mirror image to the trial in the capital of Michael Sussman, acquitted of lying to the FBI? That is to say, where Sussman was acquitted, Mr. Trump would be convicted in contradiction to the evidence. After all, doesn't the country's experience with the treatment of Donald J. Trump -- and all propaganda concocted in his name -- demonstrate that for Democrats, justice is not equal, rather: it all depends whose ox is being gored?

It is vital, to get the country back on the constitutional track, that Mark Meadows wins his day in court against Speaker Pelosi and her rogue select committee.

YUMA SCHOOL DISTRICT 1 IN GROSE VIOLATION

Several times tonight at District One School Board meeting, Duane Sheppard disputed my statements of fact. Please take a look at this:

ARIZONA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, effective 31 March 2022.

R7-2-303. Sex Education

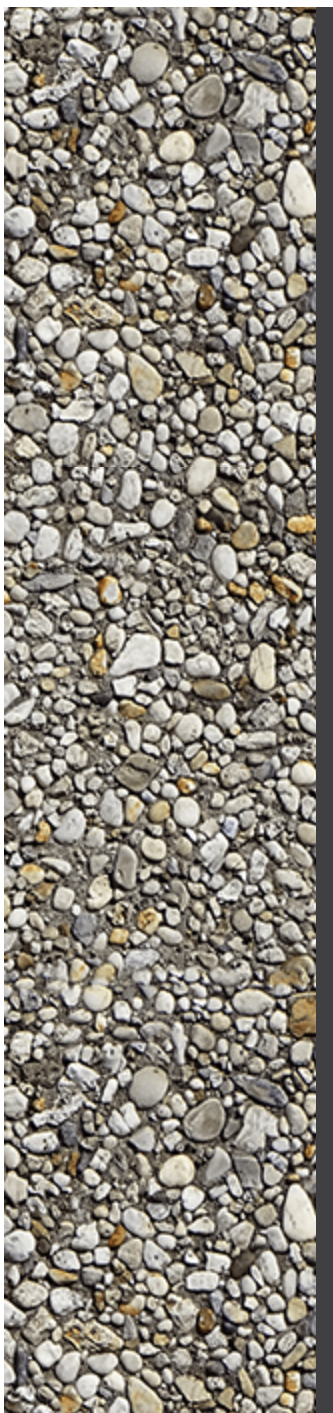
A. Instruction in sex education in the public schools of Arizona, including instruction provided after hours, shall be offered only in conformity with the following requirements. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to require a school district or charter school provide sex education instruction to pupils.

1. Common schools: Nature of instruction; approval; format. a.

Supplemental/elective nature of instruction. The common schools of Arizona may provide a specific elective lesson or lessons concerning sex education as a supplement to the health course of study.

i. This supplement may only be taken by the student at the written request of the student's parent or guardian. When the school district or charter school seeks consent pursuant to this subsection, the school district or charter school shall inform the parent or guardian of their right to review the instructional materials and activities.

ii. Alternative elective lessons from the state-adopted optional subjects shall be provided for students who do not enroll in elective sex education.



iii. School districts and charter schools may not provide sex education lessons or instruction before grade five.

iv. Elective sex education lessons shall not exceed the equivalent of one class period per day for 1/4 of the school year for grades five through eight. Yuma District One 2022-2023 school year (Tue 2 August 2022 to Thu 25 May 2023) comprises 42 weeks. Sheppard says that there are 13 lessons. Is this once a week or every day after school? If it exceeds the restrictions noted in (1v), program is in violation.

b. Local governing board approval. All elective sex education lessons to be offered shall first be approved by the local governing board.

i. Each local governing board contemplating the offering of elective sex education shall establish an advisory committee with membership representative of district size and the racial and ethnic composition of the community to assist in the development of lessons and advise the local governing board on an ongoing basis. Is a self-selected volunteer group of SIX parents “representative of district size”? According to its website, “Yuma School District One is the largest elementary school district in Yuma County with over 8,000 kindergarten through eighth grade students and more than 1,300 employees.” Clearly, SIX self-selected parents do not constitute a group “representative of district size.” Ten times six would be more appropriate: a committee of 60 members would be less than one percent (1%) of the size of the district student body. Moreover, these advisory committee members are not required to be parents. What is required is that they embody the full range of racial and ethnic composition of the community. (Caveat: nowadays, anybody can self-identify as anything; for instance, “I’se a black woman in a white man body,” to quote that funny movie.)

All meetings of committees that are authorized for the purposes of reviewing and selecting the sex education course of study shall be publicly noticed at least two weeks before occurring and be open to the public according to A.R.S. Title 38, Chapter 3, Article 3.1.

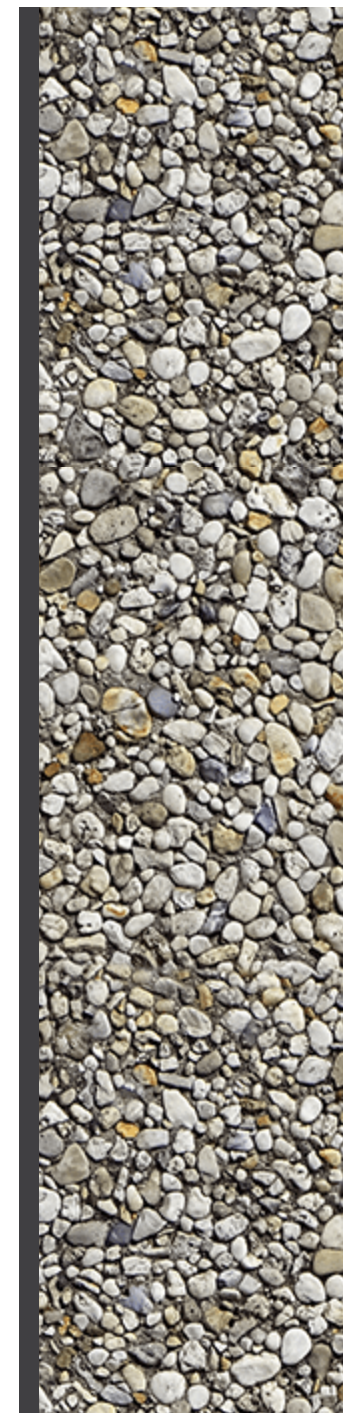
This advisory committee is charged with assisting in the development of lessons and advising the School Board on an ongoing basis:

ii. The local governing board shall review the total instructional materials and approve all lessons and curricula in the course of study to be offered in sex education.

This means that the School Board must read and consider all instructional materials and approve all the curricula and lessons in detail ... not leave it up to the Health Department to do. It is the School Board's duty; not the Health Department's duty.

Only after accomplishing the foregoing, may the following be done:

iii. The local governing board shall make any proposed sex education course of study available and accessible for review and public comment for at least 60 days





before the governing board or governing body decides whether to approve that course of study. The local governing board shall publicize and hold at least two public hearings within the 60-day period for the purpose of receiving public input at least one week prior to the local governing board meeting at which the elective sex education lessons will be considered for approval. Public input may include written comments, oral comments and comments submitted electronically.

iv. The local governing board shall maintain for viewing by the public, both online and in-person according to A.R.S. § 15-102(A)(2), the total instructional materials to be used in approved elective sex education lessons within the school district or charter school at least two weeks before any instruction is offered.

District one School Board has not made the total curriculum available for public viewing online. This constitutes a violation of these Arizona State regulations.

And District One is in violation of the following rules:

1. c. Format of instruction.

i. Lessons shall be taught to boys and girls separately.

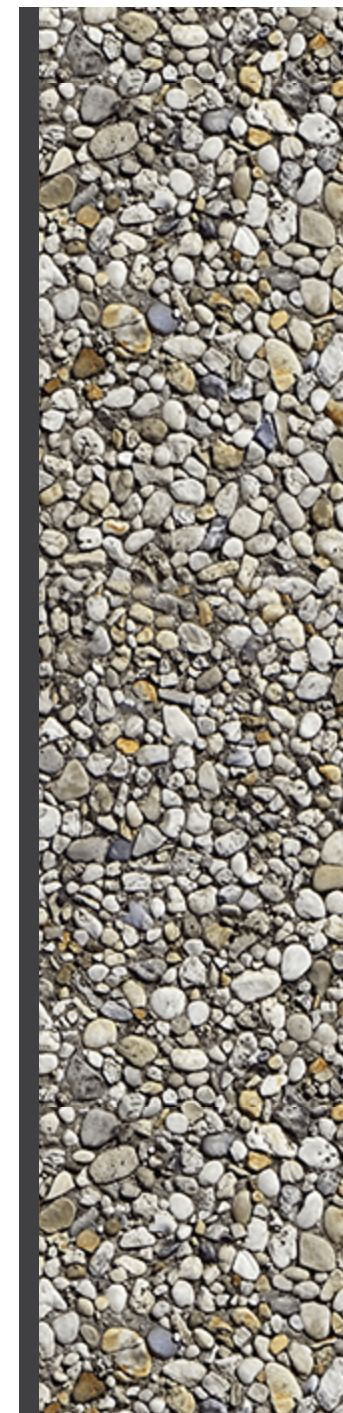
ii. Lessons shall be ungraded, require no homework, and any evaluation administered for the purpose of self-analysis shall not be retained or recorded by the school or the teacher in any form.

iii. Lessons shall not include tests, psychological inventories, surveys, or examinations containing any questions about the student's or the student's parents' personal beliefs or practices in sex, family life, morality, values or religion. District One has not mentioned that boy and girls are in separate classes, so we can only assume that they are together – in violation of regulations. Moreover, the “touchy-feely” probing into students’ “personal beliefs or practices in sex, family life, morality, values, or religion” constitutes an integral part of the Social-Emotional-Learning aspect of the curriculum ... and is in violation.

I invite you to read the entire legal document. You will see that “all sex education materials and instruction shall be age appropriate, recognize local community standards and sensitivities, [and] shall not include the teaching of abnormal, deviate, or unusual sexual acts and practices.”

School districts and charter schools shall make any existing sex education course of study available and accessible for review both online and in person by June 30, 2021.

School Board is required to submit a “Certification of compliance. All districts and charter schools offering a local governing board-approved sex education course or lesson shall certify, under the notarized signature of both the president of the local governing board and the chief administrator of the school district or charter school, compliance with this Section. Acknowledgment of receipt of the compliance certification from the State Board of Education is required as a prerequisite to the initiation of instruction.”
