Colorado River Tea Party Minutes

August 3, 2023

Jim called the meeting to order at 6 PM

Cecil gave the invocation

Gilbert led us in the Pledge of Allegiance

Nikki read the minutes from the last meeting. Gilbert made a motion to accept, Bonnie seconded, motion passed.

Ruth gave the Treasurers report. Arlene made a motion to accept, Neil seconded and the motion passed.

Legislative Report, Old Business, New Business – Nothing to report at this time

Ways and Means Committee – Jim said we need volunteers to take over this committee which is our best fund raiser. New books are available for a \$1 donation.

Gary Knight, Yuma City Councilman, is our featured speaker this evening and will be discussing what is going on with the proposed Hazardous Waste facility. Sydcoll, a non hazardous waste transfer currently has a non hazardous waste plant in Yuma. They now want to bring about a hazardous waste plant located at 13 th Street and Inger. This location is next to an agriculture field, a well within 60 feet and in a residential and commercial buildings area. The company sought a Special Use Permit (SUP) from Yuma County. The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the Environment Protection Agency (EPA) have both approved the Facility to include the handling and storage of hazardous waste with a 6-2 vote and sent it to our 5 Board of Supervisors. The applicant has now requested that this Special Use Permit application be heard by the Board of Supervisors, August 7th at 9am. They are asking for a 90 day continuance and the supervisors have to deny it or the application will be withdrawn by Sydcoll. If not the supervisors will vote and the permit could allow the handling and storage of hazardous waste on the site. Councilman Knight pointed out additional concerns from the City Council, several County Board of Supervisors and the public in general.

* Neither the city of Yuma Fire Department or City of Yuma Police Department were ever notified, consulted or contacted by the applicant for the ADEQ hazardous Materials permit and there is no known emergency plan.

* The site will have the capacity to store 228,260 gallons of hazardous waste. Typical waste would include ignitables, reactives, toxicities, heavy metals, herbicides and volatile organics. Many of these substances support spontaneous combustion stored outside in Yuma's climate.

* The hazardous materials route closest to the site runs from Avenue 3E to Highway 95 east. Hazardous materials routes should have the least impact on public health and safety in the event of a spill and far away from centers of commerce such as Yuma Palms Regional center.

* Sydcoll is not able to give ADEQ any documentation. They are non compliant and have no

contingency plan. Records are not provided to inspectors on leaks. The owners also have no intention of compromising on their location. The good news is on Friday, August 4 th , Sydcol withdrew their Special Use Permit request!!! The August 7 th meeting and hazardous waste project has been canceled.

Gosar Statement Regarding Biden Grand Canyon Land Grab

Kingman, AZ - Congressman Paul A. Gosar, D.D.S. (AZ-09), issued the following statement in response to the Biden administration’s announcement designating almost one million acres adjacent to the Grand Canyon as a national monument:

“Circumventing Congressional authority and with the swipe of a pen, Joe Biden intends to lock up one million acres of public land and permanently prohibit mining of the richest and highest-grade uranium in the United States from deposits that are far outside the Grand Canyon National Park.

Designating existing public lands as a national monument in northern Arizona is flat out wrong and irresponsible. The move represents the Biden administration’s latest massive land grab effort and will have a devastating impact on public access and use of federal lands. The designation and corresponding uranium withdrawal increases America’s reliance on foreign adversaries for minerals, threatening America’s energy, economic, and national security for generations to come.

Mohave County Supervisor Buster Johnson opposes the creation of the monument, noting: "This would have devastating impacts on Mohave County. This proposal was never coordinated with Mohave County officials, whose area will be changed forever by this designation." The actions taken today illustrate the Biden administration’s lack of interest

in stakeholders on the ground as they advance and promote a radical environmental justice agenda above all else.

Whether it is the ever-expanding war on domestic energy production, hostility to domestic mining, prohibition of gas stoves and water tanks, draconian mandates on what cars Americans can drive, or restricting the public's access and use of federal lands, the Biden administration will stop at nothing to inject Joe Biden's radical eco-agenda in every aspect of American life," **stated Congressman Gosar.**

Section 1. A frequent recurrence to fundamental principles is essential to the security of individual rights and the perpetuity of free government.

Section 2. All political power is inherent in the people, and governments derive their just powers from the consent of the governed, and are established to protect and maintain individual rights.

21. Free and equal elections

Section 21. All elections shall be free and equal, and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere to prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage.

32. Constitutional provisions mandatory

Section 32. The provisions of this Constitution are mandatory, unless by express words they are declared to be otherwise.

33. Reservation of rights

Section 33. The enumeration in this Constitution of certain rights shall not be construed to deny others retained by the people.
