Biden’s Green Building Codes Make Homes Unaffordable The Energy Department trots out new “energy conservation” codes that will greatly increase the price of building houses.

Houses aren’t cheap. Since Joe Biden has been in office, they have only gotten more expensive. In July, homes on the market hit the second highest average cost in U.S. history, coming in at nearly \$414,000. The record came last summer, and despite the increasing rate of inflation, the only reason the price has dropped slightly this year is because interest rates are so high that few homes are selling.

The Biden administration’s response to this reality is a gaslighting campaign they’ve dubbed “Bidenomics.” Everything is getting better, more jobs have been created, unemployment is way down, the deficit is reduced — these are all bogus claims that Biden and his administration have repeated, trying to convince the American public to believe the lie that life in Joe Biden’s America is better than it was under Donald Trump.

Adding insult to injury, the Biden administration is not only gaslighting the public on the state of the economy but actively making life ever more expensive for more Americans via the regulatory state.

The Biden administration has gone after appliances in Americans’ homes, from gas stoves to ceiling fans to lightbulbs. But Team Biden is targeting new homes as well. Last week, the Energy Department trotted out a \$400 million “incentive” program designed to encourage state and local authorities to adopt “green” building codes in an effort to “lower greenhouse gas emissions” and fight the “climate crisis.”

Of that \$400 million, \$240 million would go to governments to implement the “energy conservation code.” Complying with that code could raise the price of a new home by a whopping \$31,000 — or about 7.5% for that aforementioned average-priced home.

The Biden administration claims that the upfront costs of these new green

codes would be quickly recouped in overall energy savings to the tune of “billions.” But the National Association of Home Builders rejects that claim, saying these “restrictive” new codes are unnecessary due to the fact that new builds “are already highly energy efficient.” Furthermore, the association says, “Newer versions of energy codes add costs to housing production that are not paid back in efficiency gains, further exacerbating the housing affordability crisis.”

The association calculated that recouping the upfront costs of Biden’s green energy codes would take upwards of 90 years through lower energy bills. Some savings.

So, just as Biden’s push for electric vehicles is making all vehicles cost more, so his administration’s green building codes will likewise only make new homes even more unaffordable for Americans.

This is what happens when commitment to a pie-in-the-sky ideology trumps any genuine concern for people’s livelihoods and liberties.

The Initiative Proposing Jungle Primaries and Ranked Choice Voting Is as Confusing as Expected

For months we have been hearing that a small group of disgruntled political consultants and power-hungry politicians would be releasing their plan to scrap our century-old primary and general election system in favor of a confusing jungle primary/ranked choice voting scheme that will disenfranchise voters and empower special interests.

Well last week a group called “Save Democracy Arizona” rolled out their proposed election reform ballot initiative, and it is about as dysfunctional a plan as what we expected.

Reading through their proposed constitutional amendment, a sprawling 4 pages of poorly written language drafted in secret, it is abundantly clear that this won't make elections any more transparent or fair except for the special interests who support it. And it does far more to disenfranchise voters and destroy democracy than actually save it.

The first major change included in the proposed initiative is the creation of a jungle primary. If this sounds familiar, that may be because California uses a jungle primary system. That's right, we are now importing California solutions to “fix” our electoral process. Plus, voters in Arizona overwhelmingly rejected a jungle primary ballot measure a decade ago.

Under a jungle primary, every candidate—Republicans, Democrats, Libertarians, No Label Party, and Independents—would now appear on the same “primary election” ballot. The winners of the primary then would advance to the general election.

Who gets to decide who the primary winner is? The legislature, who can allow as little as two and as many as eight candidates to advance to the general. If they decide to allow three or more, the legislature must then allow for the ranking of those candidates—thus implementing Ranked Choice Voting (RCV).

So, the measure includes both California-stye jungle primaries and Alaska-style ranked choice voting, all built on the same baseless and flawed complaints about our election system that they have been making for years.

They argue that primary elections result in divisiveness, leading to a small fraction of the most partisan voters determining the outcome of elections. But California Democrats quickly learned the same was true for Jungle Primaries after their voters enacted it, where candidates from only one party advance to the general election ballot in some races, stripping voters of any choice at all.

On top of this, Jungle Primary proponents argue that independent voters (now a third in Arizona) don't have a voice in the process. But independents do get to vote in our primary elections now, they just have to decide whether they want to vote in the Republican or the Democrat primary – not *both*. Plus, Independent candidates get to bypass a primary election altogether, collecting more signatures but then advancing straight to the general election ballot—a pathway that partisan candidates can't pursue.

Finally, one third of voters being “independent” means that two thirds, a *supermajority*, do associate with a political party. So, this whole multimillion dollar effort to completely change our elections is purportedly built on a block of voters, in the extreme minority, that campaigns spend significant amounts of time and money courting in every election.

In other words, these voters are not ignored, and they do have a voice—arguably an outsized one. The truth is that Jungle Primaries and RCV aren't for independents. They're for special interests who can't win elections without changing the system. The good news is that despite months and months of planning, the proponents are divided and have split. Just days after Save Democracy filed “Make Elections Fair,” Voter Choice AZ announced they will not be supporting it and will instead move forward with filing their own initiative.

For either to be successful, they'll need to compete to raise millions to collect the necessary 383,923 signatures, plus a couple hundred thousand safety net. And then they will have to convince voters to support it—voters who have been hearing about the problems of RCV for months.

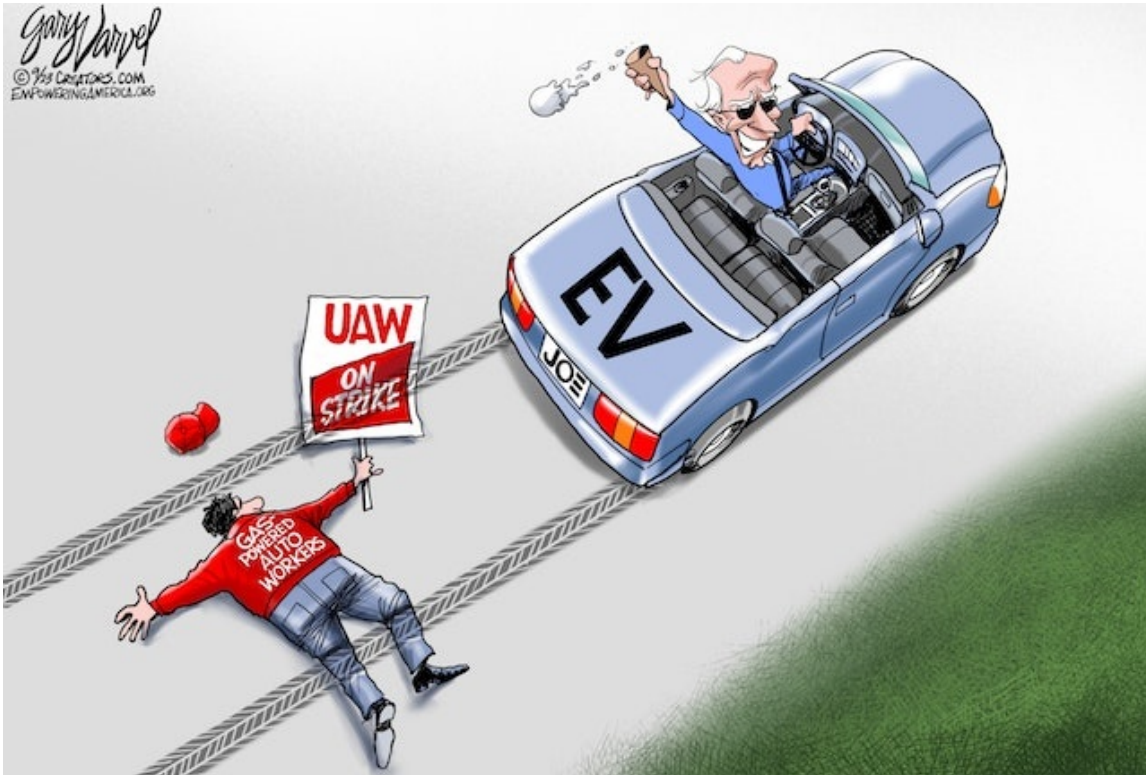

From the Arizona Constitution

Article 2:

1. **Fundamental principles; recurrence to**

Section 1. A frequent recurrence to fundamental principles is essential to the security of individual rights and the perpetuity of free government.

2. **Political power; purpose of government**

Section 2. All political power is inherent in the people, and governments derive their just powers from the consent of the governed, and are established to protect and maintain individual rights.

21. **Free and equal elections**

Section 21. All elections shall be free and equal, and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere to prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage.

32. **Constitutional provisions mandatory**

Section 32. The provisions of this Constitution are mandatory, unless by express words they are declared to be otherwise.

33. **Reservation of rights**

Section 33. The enumeration in this Constitution of certain rights shall not be construed to deny others retained by the people.
