Proposed Constitutional Amendments

PROP 128 VOTE YES

Allows the legislature to amend ballot measures that the Arizona or US Supreme Court has determined contains unconstitutional or illegal language.

PROP 129 VOTE YES

Requires ballot initiatives to pertain to a single subject, the same requirement for bills passed in the legislature.

PROP 130 (NO POSITION)

Consolidates property tax exemptions and allows for veterans to be exempted from property tax.

Proposed Laws

PROP 308 XVOTE NO

Allows individuals here illegally to receive taxpayer subsidized tuition at our universities.

PROP 309 VOTE YES

Is the Arizonans for Voter ID Act ensuring all in-person voters show valid, government issued photo ID and creates ID requirements for voting by mail.

PROP 310 XVOTE NO

Increases the statewide sales tax by 0.1% resulting in a nearly \$200 million tax increase to fund fire districts statewide.

PROP 131 (NO POSITION)

Creates the office of the Lieutenant Governor, who would run on the same ticket as the Governor and would take over existing powers within the state government, such as running the Department of Administration.



Requires any new tax or tax increase on the ballot to receive at least 60% of the vote to pass.

PROP 209 XVOTE NO

Excuses people from having to pay their debt which will increase inflation, make it harder to access credit, and shift the burden to the taxpayers who do pay their bills.

PROP 211 XVOTE NO

Requires private organizations to disclose donors to the government if they spend more than a certain amount in any given election, violating the constitutional right to privacy and association.

Jim read the Mission Statement

We had four new guests and one official at our meeting this evening.

Nikki read the minutes of the October 6th meeting. A date correction was made for the Executive Board nominations from October 29 to November 17th. Motion was made to accept minutes, seconded and the motion passed.

Matt gave the Treasurers Report. A check was written to Carla for the Tacos and Tunes booth and to Constant Contact for a six month period to pay for our Tea party newsletter. Gilbert motioned to accept, Big Wayne seconded and the motion passed.

Carla with Ways and Means said she has bags for Door Knocking and Trump All Aboard buttons still available. We have new bumper stickers, hats and new Trump hats in our inventory. Carla is asking for volunteers to take over the Ways and Means Committee and will help anyone interested for the first few months.

Cora Lee is heading up the Nomination Committee for Executive Officers and has two other members on her committee. Contact her if you are interested in running.

Jim mentioned we had a good turnout at the Tacos and Tunes event last weekend. There were 17,000 people attending. The Tea Party handed out 678 American flags plus prizes to the kids who were able to answer questions about our Government, the U.S. Constitution, the Presidents and the American flag. We signed up 12 new Tea Party members and 3 new voter registrations.

Jim introduced Robert Scarborough, who is running for one of the 3 available seats for Yuma City Council. Robert is a businessman who runs Green Trees Grocery and The Furniture Depot in Yuma. Robert has been involved with the Freedom Library for years. He and Howard Blitz have taught 9 classes at elementary schools throughout Yuma. He is ultra conservative and feels the city should be run like a business. His message is that the city spends too much money on frivolous things and we waste money. We need to keep government out of our lives.. The Hotel Del Sol and transportation hub projects are senseless and a big waste of the tax payers money. There are only 10 people a day that use the rail service and there is no partnership from the rail or bus companies. Taxpayers would be on the hook to finance and maintain these projects.

Greg Wilkinson educated us on the November 2022 Ballot Measures and recommended positions by the Republican Committee. The 100 series are Constitutional Amendments, 200 series are Citizens Initiatives, 300 series are Legislature Initiatives and 400 series are Local Ballot and Local City. Greg urged us to read each of these ballot measures and decide for ourselves but also recommended what the party recommends and the hidden agendas.

Cora Lee gave a shout out to Winnie and Wreaths Across America and said every grave in Yuma was covered last year. Gilbert motioned for the Tea Party to donate funds this year to meet that same goal. Arlene seconded and the motion passed. Cora Lee will have a list in the newsletter of all the activities coming up. Neal gave us our "Weekly Dose of Insanity" and advised to purchase the Alex Jones book, The Great Reset and watch the Anthony Fauci movie. Jim adjourned the meeting at 7:40 PM.

Why, then, are Republicans not calling them out as the party of sexualoffenders-by-proxy, of violent criminals, outlaws and scofflaws?

Their Democrat platform, after all, is one that promises to end Anglo-America, welcome the world, evict the unborn as a constitutionally enshrined right, while sundering the Bill of Rights and reveling in all manner of evil, criminal and carnal.

Elon Musk's acquisition of Twitter was finalized last Friday, and the world's richest man confirmed his reason for doing so: "I acquired Twitter because it is important to the future of civilization to have a common digital town square, where a wide range of beliefs can be debated in a healthy manner, without resorting to violence." Musk is reacting to Twitter's blatantly politicized censorship and bullying of conservatives and others who publicize opinions that challenge or expose progressive Democrats' orthodoxy.

Here's hoping that Musk keeps his nerve and reforms Twitter by purging its staff and policies that arrogantly run rough-shod over the First Amendment, based on their delusional belief that they are virtuous "brights" who are so certain of their superior knowledge that only they should be allowed to speak in the town square, and be charged with silencing heretics and blasphemers against their sacred narrative of "our democracy."

This link between free speech and political freedom, moreover, arose in ancient Athens, the first government ever to allow non-elites, or the demos, the masses, to become citizens who voted, deliberated, consented to the laws, and served in offices. No matter how low their birth, how lacking in education, or poor, they were politically equal and free.

Comedy and other genres like satire, then, have been foundational to democracy and republics from the beginning. They are important mechanisms for keeping politicians accountable to the people by humiliating them publicly and mocking their pretensions of importance and superior knowledge. Hence the use of scatological and sexual humor for 2500 years: those universal human functions reinforce the central assumption especially of representative government that all citizens are politically equal. As Lenny Bruce joked, there no man no matter how powerful who won't get on his knees and beg a woman to "just touch it." The sordid and humiliating sexual exploits of JFK and Bill Clinton confirm this eternal truth.

Needless to say, elites like Plato despised this freedom of all citizens to speak frankly and crudely to their betters. But Plato was a utopian, antidemocratic technocrat, like today's progressives who believe that "experts" and cognitive elites should govern the masses.

So why should we be surprised that tech moguls like Jeff Bezos and Bill Gates champion censoring news that challenges their political narratives and interest, or that Amazon censors books disliked by progressives?

If Elon Musk follows through and returns First Amendment rights to Twitter, he will be remembered for taking the war against censorship into one of its most consequential bastions. And let's not forget our delightful schadenfreude over watching the "woke" lose their, er, minds. As the show-tune has it, there's "no ordeal like the end of Camille."
