



Alaska - America's Dream Destination July 19 – July 31, 2021

Alaska is where you can cruise past calving glaciers, witness brown bears feeding on salmon, and race through the wilderness on a sled being pulled by a dog team.

Itinerary for the 4-night 5-day custom program July 19 – July 23 2021.

- July 19** Depart for Anchorage, Alaska; time to be determined. Transfer to our hotel for the overnight in Anchorage.
- July 20** Enjoy breakfast (included). Board your motor coach for the journey from Anchorage north to **Denali National Park**. Travel along the scenic Parks Highway where you will stop along the way and visit the **Iditarod Headquarters** in **Wasilla** and the town of **Talkeetna**, which began as a trading post when gold was first discovered in the Susitna River. This evening enjoy the **Denali Dinner Theater** (included). Overnight in Denali
- July 21** Enjoy breakfast (included). Enjoy this morning at your leisure by either participating in a complimentary park service activity or optional tour. There are many to choose from including mild or wild river rafting, flight seeing, a jet boat safari on the Nenana River, or a visit to an Iditarod champions award winning dog kennel. This afternoon, travel deep into Denali National Park on the seven hour **Tundra Wildlife Tour** looking for grizzly bear, moose, caribou, sheep and many others. A box lunch is complimentary. The Wildlife Tour is included. Overnight in Denali
- July 22** Enjoy Breakfast (included). Travel via deluxe motor coach from Denali National Park to Anchorage. In Anchorage, take a **city sightseeing** tour of the historic downtown district. There is a brief time available for lunch on your own in the downtown area. This afternoon enjoy your deluxe motor coach tour from Anchorage traveling south along the spectacular Turnagain Arm towards the **Begich Boggs Visitor Center** and enjoy a stop at the **Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center** to see Alaska's critters up close. Tour south via the scenic Seward Highway to the port community of **Seward**, gateway to the Kenai Fjords National Park. Tour this coastal community and for the remainder of the day enjoy exploring this area at your leisure. Overnight in Seward
- July 23** Enjoy breakfast (included). This afternoon, transfer to the Seward Cruise Embarkation Terminal. Bid farewell to our local guide and motor coach driver as we board the *Royal Caribbean Radiance of the Seas* for our 7 day cruise. Cruise departs at 8:00p.m.

- July 24** Cruise the Hubbard Glacier from 3:00pm to 5:00pm.
- July 25** Port of call in Juneau, Alaska arrive at 9:00am and depart at 9:00pm.
- July 26** Port of call in Skagway, Alaska arrive at 7:00am and depart at 8:30pm.
- July 27** Port of call in Icy Strait, Alaska arrive at 7:00am and depart at 4:00pm.
- July 28** Port of call in Ketchikan, Alaska arrive at 9:00am and depart at 6:00pm.
- July 29** Cruise the Inside Passage, Ak.
- July 30** Arrive in Vancouver, BC at 7:00am. Depart Seattle for our flight home. (time to be determined)

The land tour includes a local escort throughout the entire land tour. The Tundra Wildlife Tour, transfers, luggage handling, and applicable taxes are included. First class hotels (three star) are used throughout the land tour.
