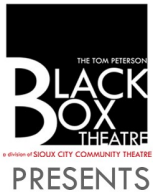

And those who know the history of our building here at SCCT know that it used to be the Shore Acres Ballroom during that time. So although I can't find anything to officially confirm it, it is believed by several people I've spoken with that he used to bring dates to the very building you're sitting in right now. Pretty cool, if I do say so myself.

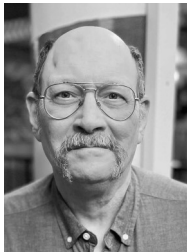
