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

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### State, Federal and Grassroots Advocacy (cont'd)

#### Recent highlights:

- Residency program funding
  - \$1.44 billion six-year reauthorization of the Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education (THCGME) program
  - 200 additional Medicare-funded GME positions
- · Medicare telehealth services extension
- · Prevention of 8.5% Medicare payment rate cuts
- Prevention of 15% payment cut to Medicare laboratory services to take effect in 2024
