Getting Here

Where to Stay

The Hale Koa Hotel is a resort serving members of the US Armed Forces and their families. Attendees who are not eligible to stay at the Hale Koa Hotel can make their hotel arrangements at any of the nearby hotels. The Hilton Hawaiian Village is right next door. Other hotels within 3 blocks include the Embassy Suites Waikiki, Ilikai Hotel, Luana Waikiki, Grand Islander, and Imperial Hawaii Resort.

Registration Opens Monday

You may pick up your **registration materials beginning on Monday, March 25th at 7:30am** at the Registration desk outside the Waikiki Ballroom. **The full final program is available [online](#).**

Breakfast will also start at 7:30am and we will begin the first session at 8:00am on Monday.

Please know that the HAOPS Primary Care Update is "green". There will be some printed copies available but please, download online before attending the conference. You can find the course syllabus to download online beginning today. Also note that there is **no Wi-Fi in the Waikiki Ballroom** but there is Wi-Fi in the hotel lobby.
