Our *Multilingual Family Support* team excels at building trust with our clients and is available to help them in **ENGLISH**, VIETNAMESE, LAOTIAN, SPANISH, **MANDARIN.** With a diverse team of professionals in place, we work purposefully to address the inequities that exist and to help our clients increase their self-sufficiency. We this through collaboration, accomplish education, youth programs, by feeding the hungry, and helping individuals to meet their goals. Our programs are a valuable investment in the community and we inspire hope and the promise of a bright future! LANFC is accredited by the Council on Accreditation and is a funded partner of the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County.





#### Family Strengthening

Out of 131 Adults served, 91% achieved their Family Support Goals in at least one area:

- Job Search and Resume Building
- Citizenship
- Completing Adult Computer Classes
- Completing Adult ESOL Classes
- Obtaining ACCESS Help
- VITA Tax Preparation
- Language Interpretation
- Immigration Support
- EBT/Unemployment Application
- Computer Lab Participation

#### **Youth Services**

Out of 182 Youth, 100% of those with Math Intervention improved their scores.

- The After School Program offered youth (grades K-8) homework assistance, a literacy program, games, tutoring, & art.
- Summer Around the World celebrated diversity and combined fun summer activities with cultural education. Each week students learned about new cultures through arts, science experiments, literacy activities, field trips, guest speakers, cooking & dance!
- Junior Leadership for HS Students offered community service and leadership skills.
- Youth Sports League engaged Middle and High School students in healthy movement.

#### Food & Community Building

The Food Pantry Received Between 500-600 Monthly Visits from People in Need.




