The last 3 months have been a whirlwind of activity for our organization.

We held 3 People & Paws monthly beach cleanups, removing 300 lb of trash from the sands of Daytona Beach, between University and Zelda beach ramps.

We celebrated the 7-year anniversary of Destination 4X4s & More, who honored us by donating all proceeds from the Treasure Chamber Charity Event they held.

We participated in The Great Daytona Beach Kiwanis Duck Race, with Daytona Dog Beach Ducks adopting 133 of the 5000 ducks racing, raising \$575 to support 36 local charities, many in support of children.

We purchased 26 dog bag stations for our new dog beach, complete with waste bags to last the entire year. We secured sponsorships for 65% of the stations and worked with Beach House Graphics to provide

informational wraps on the stations. And finally, worked with Volusia County installing stations on our beach, approach ramps, and parking lots. The sponsorships ensure we have adequate funding for another year of bags, once the dog-friendly pilot becomes permanent. YES, we maintain a paw-sitive attitude.

We launched our "Paw Ambassador" volunteer team, working with Volusia County to train 2 dozen volunteers to date. All trained volunteers received their official "Paw Ambassador" t-shirts, buckets, and supplies. They have an updated website page complete with a scheduling feature, beach cam links, and more. Their role is to model good behavior in support of maintaining a safe, environmentally sound and courteous dog-friendly beach.

We hosted November 1st opening day, providing coffee, donuts, dog treats and hydration., despite challenging weather.

We, along with some of our sponsors, hosted November 4th ribbon cutting, providing free swag, prizes and a warm welcome for all attendees.



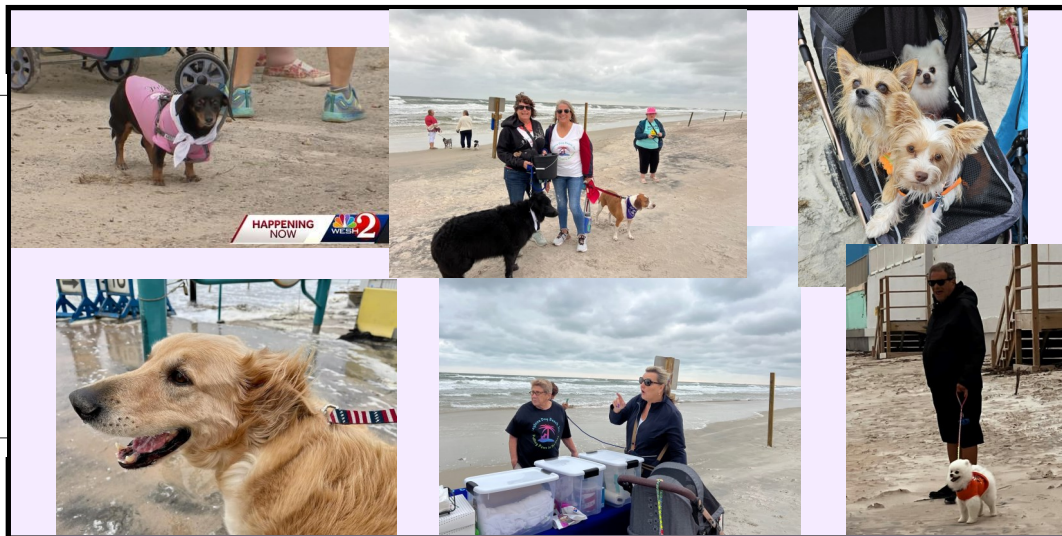

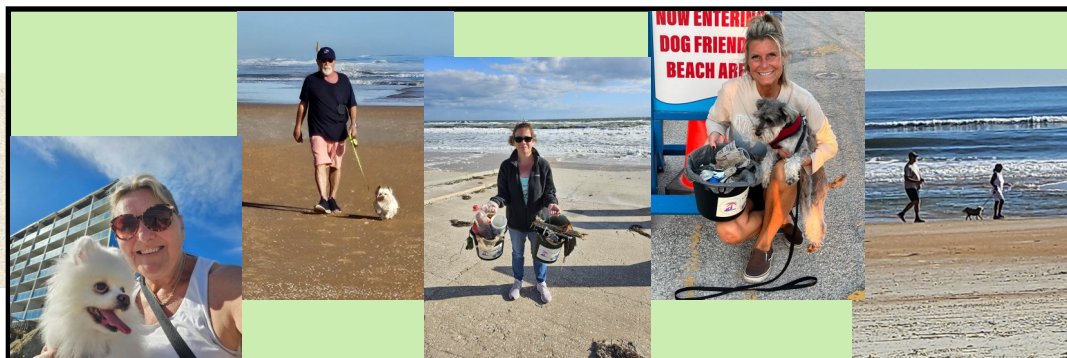

People & Paws Beach Cleanup - 2 -1/2 years, 1190 lbs

(1190 lbs of trash removed so far from our beaches and kept from the ocean, None Of It Dog Related)

As 2023, comes to an end, so does 2-1/2 years of our beach cleanups in Daytona Beach, between Zelda and Seabreeze beach ramps. Our goal in 2022, was to get “Paws in the Sand”, and we were able to do that through a Special Event Permit, issued by Volusia County. That launched our “People & Paws” monthly events. People may not realize it, but we actually paid to clean up the beach each month, just for the privilege to bring our dogs along, if we chose. And we had to carry a \$1M general liability policy to do so. What some people will do and pay just to be with their dogs!!

Our beach cleanups continued throughout this fall. We averaged 27 People and 10 Pups/month from September - November.

In September, we served as a Private Site for International Coastal Cleanup, invited by Volusia County to join in their efforts. That day alone, we removed 101 lb of trash from the beach.



We couldn't be more blessed with our core group of beach captains and a vibrant group of volunteers. Nearly 300 people have participated as volunteers over 2-1/2 years, many multiple times.



Many people have contributed, but the following people have provided the rock solid foundation of our beach cleanup efforts over the entire time. Bert Petrella our Beach Captain, Board Members Paula Flug, Brenda Balas and Mariah Petrella, Table Captains, Joyce and Brian Case and Jan and Myke Ramsdell. And our top volunteer over the years has been Joe Woody. As we move ahead, our focus will now be on maintaining the dog-friendly beach in Ormond, which we will do daily.

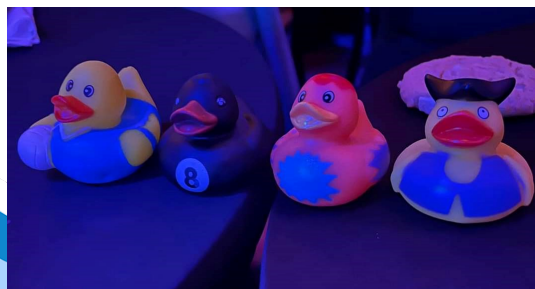


Daytona Dog Beach Ducks team has 133 Ducks in the race. Hope one of our Ducks finishes in the top 3! All Ducks are sold.
