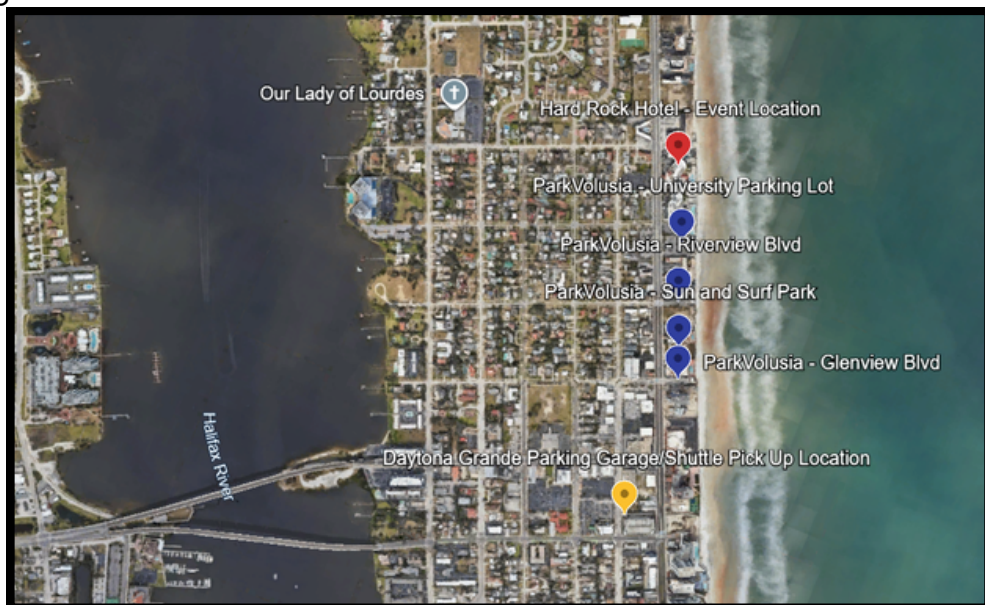

Woof Gang – Daytona and Ormond



Tonya Perry provided interview and tour to Paula Reynolds & Mia and Nanette McKeel Petrella & Deliliah!



We were welcomed by Nancy, Sales Associate, Ormond, Robyn, Manager at both locations; and Jessica, Grooming Lead, Ormond.



Tonya Perry, owner of Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming Daytona Beach and Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming Ormond Beach, has always loved animals — all animals! She is a dedicated and passionate professional committed to providing top-notch grooming services and quality pet products.

Tonya's passion for animals began at a very young age with her first dog, Poo Boo, when she was just three years old. That early bond sparked a lifelong dedication to animal welfare and care. She is married to the love of her life and has two teenage daughters who share her love for animals. Together, they care for their two beloved dogs, Stella and Pippi.

Before entering the pet care industry, Tonya had a successful corporate career in warehousing and logistics with third-party logistics (3PL) companies. However, after her daughters were born, she decided she no longer wanted to return to the corporate environment and began searching for part-time work. That journey led her to the original owners of "Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming" locations in Ormond Beach, Daytona Beach, and Savannah, Georgia.

Tonya served as the General Manager for six of their stores for approximately four years. When the Florida stores became available for purchase, she knew it was a dream opportunity. Having worked in those locations for years, she understood the business and loved the communities they served. She purchased both the Ormond Beach and Daytona Beach stores, allowing her to combine her love for animals with an area she had also grown to love.

When visiting either location, guests will find handmade dog treats made with natural ingredients. Customers and their pups can even "mix a bag" of treats from a wide assortment of table treats and decorated cookies. "Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming" is also a go-to destination for pup parties, offering birthday cookies, cakes, and decorations. In addition, both stores carry a wide selection of dog food, treats, CBD calming products, harnesses, leashes, collars, toys, and even products for cats.

Tonya says, “If you can think of it, we probably have it — or we can order it.” For pet parents concerned about calming products, especially during fireworks season, Tonya explains, “The products contain no harmful chemicals. Just make sure you are using the correct dosage and, of course, check with your veterinarian.

Tonya often shares her own experiences with her dogs to help customers. Her dog Pippi, a rescue she met while photographing shelter dogs, suffered injuries after being hit by a car. Although amputation was suggested, Tonya chose a medicinal approach, including CBD products, which now help Pippi move around comfortably without pain. Stella, her nine-year-old Labrador, struggles with anxiety, hyperactivity, food allergies, and skin issues. Tonya says many products sold at Woof Gang have been “Stella tested,” allowing her to confidently recommend them to other pet parents.

Of course, the other side of Woof Gang Bakery is grooming. Services range from full grooming packages — including haircuts, baths, blow drying, nail care, ear cleaning, and brush-outs — to mini grooms, nail grinding, baths, and specialty spa treatments. Spa services include blueberry facials, flea and tick baths, mud scrubs, oatmeal baths, and medicated baths designed to soothe sensitive or allergy-prone skin. The Ormond Beach location has two groomers, while the Daytona Beach store has four groomers and one grooming apprentice.

Tonya understands the unique challenges Florida pet owners face, especially those who spend time outdoors and at the beach. “We’re seeing more dogs with skin allergies,” she explains. “It can come from the outdoors, sun, sea, sand, or even food allergies. Sand burrs are another issue, especially for dogs with long fur, because they can cause painful matting.”

At Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming, Tonya says their philosophy is simple: “It’s grooming with love.” She believes every pet deserves patience, kindness, respect, and quality care. “When you walk in, it should feel welcoming,” she says. “We want every dog — or cat, or even pig — to be respected.” She adds with a laugh, “We do cat baths and cat nails... no pigs yet.”

Tonya is especially proud of the teams at both Woof Gang locations. Over the past year, the stores have added talented groomers who embrace the company’s mission of “grooming with love.” She also credits Manager Robyn and Daytona grooming lead Jen for helping the business continue to grow and succeed. “It takes a team to make the dream work,” Tonya says.

Woof Gang Bakery & Grooming is also proud to support Daytona Dog Beach, Inc. by helping strengthen the local community, getting more paws in the sand, and helping pet parents keep their dogs healthy and happy.
