

## THE ART OF PAINTING GREENS IN THE LANDSCAPE WITH IGOR STARITSIN

Below is a list of recommended supplies that I use while painting. Feel free to use your standard painting supplies, but please get familiar with the recommendation as it might help you follow along.

**Sketchbook/journal** and **drawing utensils** to take notes and do sketches

### **Oil Paints:**

Winsor & Newton - Titanium White  
Winsor & Newton - Naples Yellow Hue  
Winsor & Newton - Lemon Yellow Hue  
Winsor & Newton - Cadmium Yellow Hue  
Winsor & Newton - Light Red  
Winsor & Newton - Bright Red  
Winsor & Newton - French Ultramarine  
Winsor & Newton - Cobalt Blue Hue  
Winsor & Newton - Cerulean Blue Hue  
Van Gogh - Phalo Green (Optional)  
Van Gogh - Violet (Optional)  
Empty plastic container with a lid - to store remaining mix of gray paint (Optional)

**Medium:** Gamblin - Neo Magilp or Gamblin - Galkyd Lite Gel (Optional); Gamblin Cold Wax (Optional)

**Mineral spirit:** Gamsol or any other would work fine

**Brush Washer:** any type would do. You could get one at Michaels called Universal Glass Brush Washer

**Painting knife:** different sizes could help, one of any medium size and small size would do great. I also use a painting knife to mix paint

**Palette:** Any transparent or neutral gray plastic surface would do

**Easels:** Will be provided (please double check with the the gallery)

**Canvases:** 8\*10, 9\*12, 10\*12, 11\*14, 14\*18 inches

**Brushes:** I use Rosemary brushes.

Mostly Ivory Long Flat and Ivory Short Flat, Ultimate Short Flat and Ultimate Long Flat.

Sizes from 10 to 1. Fan brushes are helpful to have.

You do not need to have Rosemary brushes necessarily, any other brands you use for oil painting will work.

### **Paper towels and trash bags**
