

GETTING HERE

Halifax is conveniently linked to major destinations around the world. It is geographically closer to Boston and New York than any other Canadian city, and over one hour closer by plane to Europe than any other major North American city.


BY AIR

Halifax Stanfield International Airport (HSIA) is Atlantic Canada's principal full-service airport providing passengers with access to markets across Canada, the United States, Mexico, the Caribbean Basin, and Europe. A recognized innovator in the global airport industry, Halifax Stanfield is the first airport in North America to offer a self-service baggage drop system for all passengers and is consistently ranked among the best airports in the world.

Halifax Stanfield is the only airport in Atlantic Canada to offer Canada Customs services on a 24-hour, seven day a week basis, and U.S. preclearance.

Air carriers serving Halifax include: Air Canada, Air Saint-Pierre, Condor, Delta, Flair, Porter, Sunwing, Swoop, United, and WestJet. With over 700 flights arriving each week, you can travel to Halifax on direct flights from most Canadian cities; from major network hub cities in Boston, Chicago, Newark, New York and Philadelphia in the United States; as well as Frankfurt, Glasgow, London (Gatwick and Heathrow), Paris, and Dublin in Europe.

Once you arrive at the airport, you will find easy access to car rental agencies along with limousine, taxi and shuttle bus services to transport you to your accommodations. To learn more about our airport, visit halifaxstanfield.ca





IT'S ALL IN THE DETAILS


US PRECLEARANCE

The US Customs and Immigration preclearance facility at Halifax Stanfield makes it easy to do business and travel between the United States and Nova Scotia, as travellers can go through customs before they leave Halifax. This convenience results in a much easier arrival process in the US and much quicker connecting times to US hubs.

CUSTOMS & IMMIGRATION INFORMATION

All visitors entering Canada by air, land and sea are required to carry a valid passport, and in certain cases, a visa to be eligible to enter. Upon arrival at Halifax Stanfield, travellers will use a Primary Inspection Kiosk to scan their travel document, take their photo and complete an on-screen declaration. Those looking to save more time can complete their declaration using the CanBorder – eDeclaration mobile app and scan their quick response (QR) code at a kiosk upon arrival.
