Lakemary Center: A Beacon of Hope and Lifelong Support for **Individuals with Developmental Disabilities**

Mike Sanders shared a moving presentation about Lakemary Center, a nationally recognized nonprofit based in Paola, Kansas, just 32 miles south of the Kansas City metro. With nearly 30 years of volunteer service, Mike's insights highlighted the heart and impact of Lakemary's mission: providing comprehensive services for children and adults with autism spectrum disorder and other intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Founded in 1969, Lakemary Center has grown into a model of excellence, supporting over 450 individuals and their families across 13 states. The Paola campus spans 32 acres, including a Therapy Ranch, and currently houses 70 full-time child residents, with 22 from Missouri. The K-12 school serves 190 students, more than half of whom commute daily.

What sets Lakemary apart is its *post-graduation commitment*. While most states end services at age 18, Lakemary offers a mandatory three-year life skills program to help young adults transition into meaningful, supported independence. This bridge is vital for those who cannot mainstream into traditional adult education or employment.

Lakemary also operates 17 adult residential homes in Johnson County, KS, with 3,100 Kansans and 4,700 Missourians currently on waiting lists. Adults supported by Lakemary are thriving in community jobs at places like Garmin, McDonald's, and Lakemary's own Shredding Company. These opportunities reflect Lakemary's belief in dignity through inclusion and purpose.

To maintain its 24/7 care model, Lakemary must hire 20 new staff for every five children added to the program. The government provides a \$26,900/month subsidy per child, underscoring the level of care and resources required. With centers in 13 states, Lakemary continues to expand its reach and redefine what lifelong support can look like.
