Lynnfield Public Schools Youth Health Survey

Presentation

Summary

Since 2017, JSI and Lynnfield have collaborated to jointly conduct a youth health survey to capture vital information related to health status and certain behaviors that have been deemed as putting the health of students in middle and high school at-risk.

In fall of 2023, the Youth Health Survey was administered to all middle school and high school students. After cleaning the data per CDC standards, 85% of high school students (N=537) and 86% of middle school students (N=527) were included in the analyses.

Data is reported and analyzed for all students, as well as by grade, gender identity, sexual orientation, race, and ethnicity.

The information provided is meant to highlight key themes and provide a perspective on how the district-specific data compares to the prior year and state benchmark data. Confidence intervals were used to test for the significance of the findings within each demographic category.

There may be instances where there are large gaps between frequencies and not a statistically significant difference. This is often because of small sample sizes, which have large confidence intervals making it more difficult to detect statistical significance between groups.

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
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Reporting on the YHS

Throughout this report, we show differences by grade, gender identity, sexual orientation, race, and ethnicity. Some groups students have a significantly different prevalence of many health-risk behaviors. These are noted throughout the report as being significantly more (^) or less (^v) likely to report the behavior than another group. Though not reflected in the entirety of the report, we also show significant middle school outcomes for LGBTQ+ students. Finally, changes over time and comparisons to 2021 Massachusetts data are included.







Middle School & High School	During the past 12 months, how many times were you bullied on school property?

Bullying	(1 or more times)










During the past 30 days, how often was your mental health not good?

(sometimes, most of the time, always)











LGBTQ+ students were significantly more likely than the average middle school student to report that their mental health was not good sometimes, most of the time, or always in the past 30 days. LGBTQ+ students were also significantly more likely than the average middle school student to experience depression, engage in self-harm, and seriously consider attempting suicide in the past 12 months.









LGBTQ+ students were significantly less likely than the average middle school student to have at least one family adult to talk to about a problem.







On how many of the past 7 days did you eat breakfast? (6 or 7 days)









Middle School & High School During the past 7 days, on how many days were you physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes per day? (5 or more days)




LGBTQ+ students were significantly less likely than the average middle school student to engage in 60 minutes of physical activity on at least 5 of the past 7 days.

Screen Time	(3 or more hours)







On an average school night, how many hours of sleep do you get?


