Public Safety/ Public Health

Public Health - Coral

- applied for a CHI Index Grant with Melrose, Wakefield, Lynnfield, Stoneham that will fund an assessment of town services for better health and racial equity, working with Senior Center,
- Youth Mental Health First Aid Training February 15th and 22nd 2 day training -9am-1pm. Registrations need to be in by the end of January. Coral will get flyer out. Focused on police, fire, anyone that works with youth. Held at the new police training facility. 16 person capacity.

Police - Nick

- Narcan admin- None by LPD, maybe Fire (Glen wasn't available today)
- Continually being called for family incidents, drug-seeking behaviors
- 2 deaths this quarter, most likely due to substances this is high for Lynnfield
- Rare that a tox screen pinpoints the drug, usually a mix of drugs and fentanyl accidentally
- Fake pills in circulation that look like adderall
- Mostly adults 25+ and could be those using party drugs and not necessarily someone with a substance use disorder

- What is the best way to deliver the message of dangers to parents?
- Some families have accepted their situations and have taken action by keeping narcan in the home
- We need to normalize Narcan like CPR. Discussion around a community training that includes AED, CPR, Heimlich, and Narcan - now may be a good time since the Damar Hamlin Cardiac Arrest in the NFL. Tie in Narcan and make it an overall safety class -"three ways to save a life?" Glen did a public narcan training and Nick thinks he would be open to doing it again.
- Public safety has always had narcan available if needed. It is also in the schools.
- Security camera deferred to school department IT
