Enhanced Criminal Response Liaison

The office of the Winnebago County State's Attorney is hiring a full time Enhanced Criminal Response Liaison.

Position Summary: This position will review inmate partner communication with victims of domestic violence and review body camera footage for the Winnebago County State's Attorney's Domestic Violence unit, particularly in the unit's felony division. Uncovering the coercion of domestic violence victims by their abusers is crucial to ensuring justice in domestic violence cases. This position will work hand-in-hand with prosecutors and investigators to uncover the all too common practice of witness harassment or intimidation in domestic violence prosecutions. This position will be called to research that harassment, document it so that prosecutors can bring motions alleging Forfeiture by Wrongdoing, and ultimately testify in court.

Position Requirements: All applicants must possess an associate's degree or equivalent experience. Successful candidates will have a background in the areas of domestic violence and/or criminal justice or criminal law. Additional qualifications include experience with computer programs, data collection, Microsoft Office Suite, and coordinating multidisciplinary teams. Bilingual capabilities are preferred.

Grant Funded Advisement: This position is funded by grant no. 15JOVW-24-GG-01490-POLP awarded by the Office on Violence Against Women, U.S. Department of Justice. The Enhancing Investigation and Prosecution of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking (EIP) is currently set to expire 9/30/27. Continued funding may become available based on program results. Acceptance of this position shall not be construed as a guarantee of employment beyond the grant funded period.
