Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that the Honorable Judge Debra Schafer sentenced **Dyandre Price, Sr. (DOB: 12/18/1980)** to 13 years in the Department of Corrections for Aggravated Robbery. The defendant will also be on mandatory supervised release for one year after he is released from prison. Price pled guilty to the offense in June. The sentence is eligible to be served at 50%.

On October 24, 2025, Rockford Police were flagged down by a 65-year-old man, who reported he was the victim of an armed robbery that had occurred earlier in the month. The victim said he was walking home on 16th Avenue when he was approached by a male who had been hiding in the bushes. The suspect struck the victim in the head with a handgun, then hit him several more times as he was lying on the ground. The suspect took the victim's wallet and cell phone. The victim was able to identify the defendant, Dyandre Price, as the person who attacked him in a photo lineup. Surveillance video, collected by police from cameras in that area, also shows the incident unfolding as the victim described it.

Aggravated Robbery is a Class 1 Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 4-30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by one year of mandatory supervised release.

The Rockford Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorney Nathaniel Huss handled the prosecution.

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
