Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that **Adrian Jaramillo (DOB: 12/11/1998)** was found guilty of three counts of Predatory Criminal Sexual Assault and four counts of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse after a two day jury trial in absentia before the Honorable Judge Scott Paccagnini. A trial in absentia is a criminal proceeding in a court of law in which the person being tried is not present.

Rockford Police Detectives were assigned to conduct a sexual assault investigation that was originally reported at a hospital in Park Ridge, Illinois. An adult female told staff that the defendant, Adrian Jaramillo, had sexually assaulted two of her children at a home in Rockford. The abuse had occurred multiple times between January and September of 2022. Since the defendant was not present in court, his recorded interview with police after the offense was played for the jury. In that video, Jaramillo admitted to some of the allegations. One of the victims bravely testified, and recalled the sexual acts Jaramillo performed on her to the jury. She was only six years old at the time of the abuse.

Predatory Criminal Sexual Assault is a Class X Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-60 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by three years to natural life of mandatory supervised release. Under Illinois Law, this is a mandatory life sentence since there were two different victims included in the indictment.

Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse is a Class 1 Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 4-15 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by two years of mandatory supervised release and lifetime registration as a sex offender.

Jaramillo is scheduled to be back in court on May 21, 2026, before Judge Paccagnini in Courtroom 478 at the Winnebago County Courthouse. The defendant had previously failed to appear in court and a bench warrant for his arrest remains outstanding and active.

The Rockford Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorneys Kris Carpenter and Kirstin Krivanec are handling the prosecution.
