PRESS RELEASE February 28, 2022 State's Attorney J. Hanley

Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that on Friday, February 25, 2022, **Anzio King (DOB: 1/22/77)** was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Debra D. Schafer as follows: 36 years for Armed Robbery and Home Invasion, 20 years for Residential Burglary, 5 years for Unlawful Restraint, and 22 years for two counts of Criminal Sexual Assault. With consecutive sentencing on some of the counts, King's aggregate sentence amounts to 80 years in prison.

On December 3, 2018, Rockford police responded to the 2200 block of 7th Street for a report of battery and criminal sexual assault. Upon investigation, police learned that the Defendant, along with others, forced their way into the victim's apartment without permission, and made demands for money and property. In the process, the victim was struck in the face, causing a laceration under her lip. Afterwards, the Defendant forced the victim to engage in sexual intercourse with him against her will.

In this case, due to the Defendant's criminal history, the sentencing ranges for his crimes are as follows: Armed Robbery and Home Invasion are Class X Felonies, punishable by 6-60 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by 3 years of Mandatory Supervised Release (MSR); Residential Burglary is a Class 1 Felony, punishable by 6-30 years, followed by 3 years of MSR; Unlawful Restraint is a Class 4 Felony, punishable by 1-6 years, followed by 1 year of MSR; and Criminal Sexual Assault is a Class 1 Felony, punishable by 6-30 years, followed by 3 years to life of MSR. Upon his release from prison, the Defendant will be required to register as a sex offender for life.

The City of Rockford Police Department was responsible for the investigation and Assistant State's Attorney Patrick Bruce handled the prosecution of Anzio King.
