Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that on September 12, 2022, **Devin L. Stevenson (DOB 5/16/1984)** was sentenced to 20 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections by the Honorable Judge Brendan Maher for the offense of Attempt First Degree Murder (Class X Felony).

On May 16, 2018, Devin Stevenson shot at an individual who was driving his vehicle on Kishwaukee Street. The individual drove himself to the hospital and identified Devin Stevenson as the shooter. Devin Stevenson was located at a residence along with a firearm that matched the casings located at the scene.

The sentence is to be served at 85% and followed by a Mandatory Supervised Release term of 3 years.

The Rockford Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorneys Taylor Nesbit and David Smith handled the prosecution.
