Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that on September 7, 2022, **Kahlid Holliday (DOB 5/13/1997)** was found guilty of Attempt First Degree Murder and Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm after a jury trial before Judge Jennifer Clifford.

On October 23, 2021, Kahlid Holliday was in an argument with his ex-girlfriend about returning her car. Holliday chased after his ex-girlfriend, while his three children were in her car, on I-90 and shot in the direction of his ex-girlfriend's vehicle twice. One of the bullets struck the driver's side window. Fortunately, no one was injured as a result of the shooting.

The case is set for a status hearing on October 7, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 467 of the Winnebago County Courthouse.

The Illinois State Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorneys Ali Friend and Alex Ronning handled the prosecution.
