Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that on October 4, 2023, **Kevin Lundgren (DOB: 2/13/1998)** was found guilty of Aggravated Stalking, three counts of Violation of Order of Protection, and Violation of Bail Bond after a jury trial in front of the Honorable Judge Jennifer Clifford.

In March of 2023, Kevin Lundgren was subject to an active Order of Protection which prohibited him from contacting, harassing, stalking, or coming within 300 feet of the victims - a mother and daughter. Lundgren was also on pretrial release for a prior charge of Violation of Order of Protection, and was ordered to have no contact with the mother. On March 7th, 2023, Rockford Police were notified that Kevin Lundgren violated the order of protection by following the daughter home. When the daughter arrived home, the mother spotted Lundgren following her and called police. Then, on March 15th, 2023, police received a report stating that Kevin Lundgren had again violated the order of protection by approaching the daughter while she was shopping.

Aggravated Stalking is a Class 3 Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 2-5 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The offense also carries up to four years of mandatory supervised release after the Department of Corrections sentence is served.

The Rockford Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorneys Andrew Marcum and Luke Ranard handled the prosecution.
