Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that **Marcus D. Green (DOB: 6/7/1981)** was found guilty of Armed Habitual Criminal and Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance after a jury trial before the Honorable Judge Debra Schafer.

On March 20, 2023, members of the Winnebago County Narcotics Unit and Detective Bureau executed a search warrant at a home in the 1300 block of Garrison Avenue in Rockford. Deputies located the defendant, Marcus Green in a bedroom inside the home. During a subsequent search, deputies found almost 100 grams of white rock-like substance, a firearm and ammunition. Deputies also located drug packaging materials with white residue that field tested positive for the presence of cocaine. The white rock-like substance tested positive as cocaine at the Illinois State Police Crime Lab. Green was previously convicted of Manufacturing or Delivering Cocaine in 2004 and 2000.

Armed Habitual Criminal is a Class X Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by three years of Mandatory Supervised Release.

Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance is a Class X Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-60 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by three years of Mandatory Supervised Release.

Green is scheduled to be back in court on July 19, 2024 at 9:00 am in front of Judge Schafer in Courtroom 317 of the Winnebago County Courthouse.

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorney Emily Palmer and Illinois Supreme Court Rule 711 Intern Ranikka Moore are handling the prosecution.
