### **State's Attorney J. Hanley**

Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces **Antwon D. Glover (DOB: 3/1/1992)** was found guilty of four counts of Armed Robbery and two counts of Home Invasion after a two day jury trial before the Honorable Judge Debra Schafer.

On February 1, 2026, Rockford Police responded to a residence in the 1800 block of Carney Avenue for a Home Invasion. Upon arrival, officers met with two victims, one had noticeable injuries to his face and hands. The victim was taken to the hospital for treatment. During trial witnesses testified that the defendant, Antwon Glover, and two other men, knocked on the door of the Carney Avenue residence, then pointed guns at the homeowners and entered the home. Glover and two other suspects took money and jewelry. They also hit one of the homeowners with a gun, several times causing multiple lacerations, one of which required staples. In footage from surveillance videos showed during trial, the defendant was seen entering the Carney Avenue residence, then later leaving in a blue Chevy Malibu. Shortly after the incident, SCOPE officers conducted a traffic stop on the blue Malibu, which was being driven by Glover. The defendant was also wearing the same black jacket during the traffic stop as one of the suspects from the home invasion.

Armed Robbery is a Class X felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by three years of mandatory supervised release.

Home Invasion is a Class X Felony that is punishable by a sentence of 6-30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Each sentence to be served at 85% if the Court finds severe bodily injury.

Glover is scheduled to be back in court on July 2, 2026, in front of Judge Schafer in Courtroom 317 of the Winnebago County Courthouse.

The Rockford Police Department conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorneys Emily Palmer and Rio Ottolino are handling the prosecution.
