Winnebago County State's Attorney J. Hanley announces that **Davaris A. Graham (DOB: 10/30/1990)** was sentenced to 12 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections as part of a negotiated plea to Armed Robbery charges.

On October 25, 2023, Rockford Police Officers responded to Stumpy's Pub in the 5800 block of Columbia Parkway for an armed robbery. Prairie Street Gaming (PSG) employees reported they arrived at the business to replenish the gaming machines. When they arrived, they were approached by two men one of whom was armed with a firearm, and demanded cash. One of the suspects is seen on surveillance video pointing a gun at a security employee who was assisting the PSG employees, while the other gathers unmarked bags of cash from the PSG van. A third suspect pulls up in a truck to collect the bags of cash. The defendant was identified as the owner of the pickup truck. The investigation also revealed that the defendant had received information from an individual relating to the timing and route information of the PSG employees and van. The cases against two other codefendants are still pending.

Armed Robbery is a Class X Felony with a sentencing range of 6-30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections to be followed by 18 months of Mandatory Supervised Release.

The Rockford Police Department and Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office conducted the investigation in this case. Assistant State's Attorney Kirstin Krivanec handled the prosecution.
