Diaper Crib – over 13,000 diapers were delivered from May until December.

Costs for food at our fish frys increased approximately 20% over last year. Motion was made and approved to change price to \$15 per meal. Fried = 3 pieces, Baked = 1 eight ounce piece. Extra pieces of fried fish will be \$2 each.

Initial Fish Fry order will be approximately \$4000.
