## Lincoln County Library System

Board of Trustees Meeting, February 17, 2022 1:00 p.m. – Lincoln County Library – Kemmerer, Wyoming

The meeting was called to order at 1:03 p.m. by Chairman Tratnik. Present were Board of Trustees members – Traci Countryman (via tele-conference), Lynn Donnelley (via tele-conference), Diane Sakai, (via tele-conference), Rosalie Tratnik and Lorelle McPhee (via tele-conference); Assistant Director - Missy Harris and Director – Richard Landreth.

Chairman Tratnik asked if there were any changes to the agenda or to the minutes of January 20, 2022. Richard added Discussion Items: f. Staffing. There were no other changes. The amended agenda and minutes were accepted by consensus.

Closures: The Lincoln County Library system was closed on January 5-6, due to inclement weather.

Facilities: The Star Valley Branch has been having sewer problems since late December. The bathrooms are currently inoperable. The County has been notified. Repairs to the sewer line will possibly not occur until spring.

Upcoming events were noted.

Staffing: Sheryl, Technical Services, is retiring in June.

Financial statements, branch manager's and youth service librarian's reports were reviewed.

Chairman Tratnik asked if there were any public comments. There were none.

Lorelle moved and Lynn seconded to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Tratnik adjourned the meeting at 1:19 p.m.
