## Minutes:

- I. Call to Order by Scott Hills at 5:15pm

  - A. 2023 Budget: Matt explained that the Mill is up \$581 this year compared to last year. Matt explained changes that were made to the budget and the committee discussed. In the general fund there was \$8,653.86 left to budget for suggested projects. The committee agreed to allocate \$4,000 of the funds to Pumpkin Park and \$4,653.86 towards demolition of the Girl Scout Cabin. Matt explained the building fund and the amounts allocated to each fund. The building fund had an additional amount of \$2,933.50 left to allocate. The committee discussed and decided to allocate the additional funds to the Vehicle/Large Equipment Fund to continue to build towards the purchase of a used toolcat. Matt also shared that the Grafton Park Board received 5 Special Assessments for Schumacher Park, Westview Tennis Courts, and 8th Street Diamond properties totaling \$49,760.62. Matt estimated the 2023 cost to be \$6,398.86. Matt reached out to Connie Johnson at the City of Grafton, but had not received replay with the exact numbers. Matt explained that he will have Connie's numbers at the 1st reading of the 2023 budget.
  - B. Ryer made a motion to present the 2023 budget with the noted changes to the general, building, and special assessment funds to the Grafton Park Board on Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup> at 11:45am. Jon seconded the motion, motion passed all approved.
