## **Minutes:**

- I. Call to Order by Kristi Olson at 5:15pm

## II. Personnel:

a. Kristi turned the meeting over to Bill. Bill explained that Todd Janikowski had turned in his 2 week notice and his last day would be May 25<sup>th</sup>. Grafton Parks will be placing an ad in the Weekly Source, Walsh County Record, KXPO Jobline, and ND Job Service.
