

## Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting April 20, 2026

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on April 20, 2026, as advertised.

All 3 Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from March 16, 2026 meeting.

Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as read and to be filed for audit. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor gave the following EMS reports. Northen York County Fire and EMS had 38 dispatches for March; none were in the Township. Wellsville Fire Company had 31 dispatched for March, 3 were in the Township. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS had 36 calls for March, 3 were in the Township. There was no report from Penn State Health Life Lion EMS.

### Subdivision Plans:

John and Karen Mayer presented updated plans for Parcel KD-51 E, 80 Shippensburg Rd. The plan is to subdivide the two existing homes to their own parcels. The plan showed permanent stone monuments as required and clear sight triangles for each driveway. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to have the Secretary sign the DEP Non-Building Waiver.

Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the plan as presented. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion.

### Business from the Floor:

Resident Patricia Dapp had several questions regarding trash. She is very pleased that recycling is included with trash pick-up and the price of the contract. She also questioned whether the Township is looking into Data Center requirements. Supervisor Dan McGregor said they have had conversations but do not have an ordinance in place yet. Solicitor Sharon Myers said she will supply the Supervisors with more samples for Data Center Ordinances for them to review.

Resident Andrew Baumgardner asked if the Township could get Penn Dot to relocate the Horse and Buggy sign that they installed just south of the intersection of Barrens Church Rd and Baltimore Pike. It blocks the view when you try to pull out onto Baltimore Pike. The Secretary will call them.

### Old Business:

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to have the Solicitor advertise for an Ordinance for a Stop Sign to be placed on Willow Glen Rd as per the Traffic Study from LTAP. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor opened bids as advertised. 3 bids were submitted for various stones. York Building Products, Vulcan, and Kinsley Materials. Supervisor Dan McGregor made a

motion to accept the bids from York Building on the unit price FOB Plant. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

2 bids were submitted for E-3 Asphalt Emulsion delivered. Russell Standard and Midland Asphalt Materials. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to award the bid to Midland Asphalt Materials. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to award the only bid for Superpave Asphalt delivered to York Material Group. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

One bid was submitted for Line Painting, D.E. Gemmill. Supervisor Harlen, Jr. made a motion to award the bid to D.E. Gemmill for line painting. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Specialty Emulsions extended last year's bid price for CRS-( E-3) for pick up, in the tar kettle, until April 19, 2027.

Bids for various fuels were tabled to see what takes place with the current situation with oil prices.

### New Business:

Supervisor Travis Sherman reported on a Municipal Leader's Summit he attended at Dover Township, sponsored by Senator Dawn Keefer. They discussed items like the Data Centers, Zoning and Rapid Bridge Response Program. Supervisor Anderson thanked him for taking the time to attend and representing the Township.

### Solicitor's Report:

Solicitor Shared Myers had nothing else to discuss.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to pay the bills out of the General Funds Account totaling \$26,174.13 and the State Account totaling \$8,341.14. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 P.M. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.
