

Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting
May 18, 2026

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on May 18, 2026, as advertised.

All 3 Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from April 20, 2026 meeting.

There was no report from Penn State Health Life Lion EMS. Northern York County Fire and EMS have provided all reports up to date as required in the contract. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS have provided the financial reports so far. Wellsville Fire Company has not provided any reports as required yet.
