

Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting January 19, 2026

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on January 19, 2026, as advertised.

All 3 Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the 2026 Reorganizational Minutes as presented. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from December 15, 2025 meeting. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the Treasure's report as read and to be filed for audit. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor gave the following EMS reports. For the month of November, Penn State Health Life Lion had 148 total dispatches in Northern York division, 3 of those were in Washington Township. Wellsville Fire Company was dispatched to 55 calls for the month of December, 7 were in the Township. Wellsville had a total of 514 dispatched for the year 2025, 28 were in the Township. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS had a breakdown of calls. For October they had 37 calls, 2 were in the Township. For November they had 39 calls, 2 were in the Township and for the month of December, 29 calls and 5 were in the Township.

Subdivision Plans:

There were no plans presented.

Business from the Floor:

There was no business from the floor.

Old Business:

There was no old business to discuss.

New Business:

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr made a motion to adopt Resolution 2026-02 reaffirming SEK & CO as the Township's CPA. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to exonerate the Tax Collector from collecting unpaid per capita taxes for 2025. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Travis Sherman made motion to reappoint Irvin Spoonhour, with Approved Code Services as the Building Code Official for Washington Township. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Travis Sherman made a motion to have the Solicitor advertise bid information for Trash Haulers for Washington Township residents. Bids will be opened at February BOS meeting. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

After a brief discussion for Zoning Hearing Board Solicitor, Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to appoint John Elliot, Esq., and Gavin Markey, Esq. to represent the Washington Township Zoning Hearing

Board. They both are with Ream, Carr, Markey, Woloshin & Hunter, LLP. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Solicitor's Report:

Solicitor Sharon Myers discussed information for an ordinance that would allow compensation for a Supervisor that serves on the Township's Planning Commission, as long as their combined compensation does not exceed the statutory limit as provided in 53 P.S. §65606. Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to have the Solicitor prepare the Ordinance for next month's meeting. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to pay the bills out of the General Funds Account totaling \$10,047.66 and the State Account totaling \$1,513.60. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:13 P.M. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.
