

Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting February 16, 2026

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on February 16, 2026, as advertised.

All 3 Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from January 19, 2026 meeting. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as read and to be filed for audit. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor gave the following EMS reports. For the month of December, Penn State Health Life Lion had 174 total dispatches in Northern York Division, 8 of those were in Washington Township, which 6 were handled by Penn State. Northern York County Fire and EMS had 36 dispatches for January, 1 was in the Township. Wellsville Fire Company did not provide a report. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS had 34 calls for January, 3 were in the Township.

Subdivision Plans:

There were no plans presented.

Business from the Floor:

SPCA Director Steven Martinez spoke on reasons why the Township should renew their 2026 membership. He reported as of today's date there were 5 of the 72 municipalities in York County that have not renewed, Washington Township was one of the 5.

There was no other business from the floor.

Old Business:

Trash Hauler Bids were opened from 5 haulers that sent responses. Penn Waste sent "No Bid." Republic, Goods, Anthracite and Castella all submitted bids. Supervisor Travis Sherman made a motion to award the bid to Anthracite Waste Services. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion. The awarded bid for 2026 (96-gallon cart for trash, 64-gallon cart for recycling and 1 bulk item per week) \$381.00, 2nd year \$388.00 per year and 3rd year \$396.00 per year.

After another discussion on the SPCA agreement, Supervisor Travis Sherman made a motion to approve the 2026 SPCA Agreement. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion. The cost for 2026 is \$2,188.00 which is an increase of \$246.00 from last year.

Supervisor Dan McGregor informed residents that Penn Dot has completed their traffic study on RT 194 and will be installing Horse Drawn Vehicle warning signs.

The Supervisors reviewed the proposed Ordinance 2026-01 Supervisor Compensation for PC member.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr made a motion to have the Solicitor advertise this ordinance for adoption. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion.

New Business:

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr made a motion to adopt Resolution 2026-03 adding land to Washington Township Ag Security Area. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion. The land added was Parcel KC-7F, located on Creek Rd with 112.79 acres.

Supervisor Travis Sherman made a motion to set Spring Clean-up dates for April 8th, and 9th from 8:00-3:30 and April 10th, 8:00-12:00. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Solicitor's Report:

Solicitor Ethan Kincaid was present for Attorney Myers. He reviewed the information that he will be discussing with her. He also announced a free seminar that CGA Law will hold on March 25th on Municipal Business matters. RSVP is required.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to pay the bills out of the General Funds Account totaling \$14,489.85 and the State Account totaling \$6,698.65. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:13 P.M. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.
