

Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting December 15, 2025

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on December 15, 2025, as advertised.

All Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from November 17, 2025 meeting. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr., made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as read and to be filed for audit. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor gave the following EMS reports. There was no report for Penn State Health Life Lion EMS. Northern York County Fire Rescue EMS had 38 dispatches for November. There were 2 in the Township. Wellsville Fire Company was dispatched to 49 calls for the month; 3 were in the Township. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS was dispatched to 39 calls for the month of November. There was no breakdown for the Townships.

Vince Brown, representing Wellsville Fire Company, reported that this will be his last meeting to attend since Sandy Brown will no longer be the President. He thanked the Supervisors for working together and they thanked Vince for his time and information he provided.

Subdivision Plans:

There were no plans presented.

Business from the Floor:

Karen and John Mayer, residents at 80 Shippensburg Rd asked questions on how to subdivide their property. At one time their property was 2 separate parcels, but in 2001 they had both parcels put on 1 deed. Solicitor Myers advised them to contact a surveyor to have plans drawn up to provide to the Washington Township Planning Commission.

Old Business:

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr made a motion to close the regular meeting at 7:12 P.M. to conduct the hearing for the updated Solar Ordinance, as advertised. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion. Solicitor Myers provided all information for the Solar Ordinance. After a brief discussion Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to close the hearing. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr seconded the motion. Hearing was closed at 7:21 P.M. The regular BOS Meeting was reopened. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2025-03, Solar Ordinance. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to adopt the 2026 Budget as presented.

Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to table the SPCA agreement again. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor said there is no updated information on the traffic study for Willow Glenn and Locust Grove Rd or from Penn Dot for Horse Drawn signs on Rt 194.

New Business:

Supervisors agreed to set the time for 2:00 P.M. for the reorganizational meeting on January 5, 2026. The Secretary will advertise this meeting.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to adopt Resolution 2025-03 setting Per Capita, Reality Transfer and Real Estate Taxes for 2026. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion. Rates remain the same as they were with no increase or any new taxes.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to appoint Jennifer Stefanick for the 6-year Audit position. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to appoint Thomas (Boone) Brumagen for the 4-year Audit position. Supervisor Dan McGregor seconded the motion. Both positions were appointed by the York County Board of Election through their election lottery. One person resigned the other was not a resident of Washington Township.

Solicitor's Report:

Solicitor, Sharon Myers, had nothing else to discuss.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to pay the bills out of the General Funds Account totaling \$8,228.24 and the State Account totaling \$349.99. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:33 P.M. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.
