

Washington Township Board of Supervisor's Meeting March 16, 2026

The Washington Township Board of Supervisor's met at the Municipal Building on March 16, 2026, as advertised.

All 3 Supervisors were present.

Chairman Dan McGregor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from February 16, 2026 meeting. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as read and to be filed for audit. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. made a motion to amend the agenda after new information regarding a traffic study from Penn Dot was received in the afternoon. Supervisor Travis Sherman seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor gave the following EMS reports. Northern York County Fire and EMS had 43 dispatches for February, 2 were in the Township. Northeast Adams Fire & EMS had 39 calls for February, 5 were in the Township. There was no report from Penn State Health Life Lion or Wellsville Fire Company.

Subdivision Plans:

There were no plans presented.

Business from the Floor:

Resident Bonnie Huber on Kralltown Rd asked what could be done about the water run-off at her driveway. Supervisor Dan McGregor said they will look into the issue and maybe they can blacktop along the edge of the road. They also suggested she might want to put a new pipe under her driveway to help with the water flow.

Old Business:

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to amend Resolution 2026-03 adding land to Washington Township Ag Security Area, with updated name change per Solicitor Sharon Myers. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion. The land added was Parcel KC-7F, located on Creek Rd with 112.79 acres. The name now shows Wayne Trostle as owner.

Supervisor Dan McGregor informed residents that Penn Dot has completed their traffic study on Willow Glen Rd, Locust Grove Rd, and State Game Rd. The Supervisors agreed to table this issue until Supervisor McGregor speaks with Penn Dot again for road name clarification.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2026-01 Supervisor Compensation for PC member, as advertised. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.

Supervisor Dan McGregor reminded residents of Spring Clean Up on April 8th and 9th from 8:00-3:30 and on April 10th from 8:00-12:00.

He also reminded residents to turn in trash letters for service by April 30th.

New Business:

Supervisor Travis Sherman made a motion to have the Secretary advertise for bids to be opened at next month's BOS Meeting for various stones, E-3, black top, and fuel. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion..

Supervisor Dan McGregor informed residents that Ag Security applications are due by June 1st in the Washington Township Office.

Solicitor's Report:

Solicitor Shared Myers had nothing else to discuss other than to mention a Municipal Law Seminar that will be held March 25 at her office. RSVP is required to attend.

Supervisor Dan McGregor made a motion to pay the bills out of the General Funds Account totaling \$6,582.20 and the State Account totaling \$1,044.18.. Supervisor Harlen Anderson, Jr. seconded the motion.
