British Columbia's archaeological sites on land and in the intertidal zones are protected under the *Heritage Conservation Act*. Protected marine site types include shipwrecks and aircraft crash locations, as well as submerged habitation, rock art, and burial sites. These sites may only be altered under the supervision of a professional archaeologist and under a permit, issued by the Archaeology Branch.

Kleanza offers British Columbia's only WorkSafe BC certified marine archaeologist. Rob Field is both a terrestrial and underwater archaeologist qualified to hold HCA permits. He is available to conduct: archaeological overview assessments, monitoring, and mitigation; underwater site surveys; site documentation; and, sub-aquatic and inter-tidal testing. Rob is also a skilled presenter, teacher, and technical writer.
