Working Ranch Horse classes (versus Working Cow Horse) have a ground tie portion where you ride into arena to the center and face the judge, dismount, remove and replace the bridle/bit, lift hooves called for by judge, walk completely around horse to demonstrate the horse can ground tie, then remount. Ride an abbreviated reining pattern. Then call for cow to box at the one end. This class has been regularly part of the FQHR World Round Up and our Wisconsin members have not had the opportunity to become proficient in this class.

- 7 All Day Cattle Fee from \$100 to \$150
- 8 Camping with Electricity from \$20 to \$30 per night
- 9 Stall Fees From \$42/day \$57/weekend to \$48/day \$68/weekend
- 10 Barn Tie Fees from \$22/day or \$39/weekend to \$25/day or \$45/weekend and ONLY IF AVAILABLE
- 11 Shavings from \$7 to \$8
