- NATIVE PLANTS:** Select from several varieties that grow in Orange County. Our expert native plant guru will answer all your questions. Learn how to care for these low-water use plants.
- VEGETABLES:** Mostly cool season. Arugala, bok choy, spinach, collard, kale, lettuce, machi, microgreens, cat grass and swiss chard. All of these plants grow well in Orange County.
- HERBS:** Basil, thyme, marjoram, parsley, sage, tarragon & others. Availability very dependent on our weather.
- HYDROPONICS:** Sally Richards will be teaching how to plant a hydroponic plant for the home gardener. For a small fee, we will have a “make and take” fully self contained hydroponic lettuce to take home.
- SUCCULENTS:** Several varieties to choose from. Low water use plants.
- HOUSEPLANTS:** Pothos, Sanseveria, Peperomia, trailing Jade. Portulacaria afra and variegated Spider plants in ceramic pots.
- BEE TEAM:** Learn about bees and pollinators. See worker bees, queen bee and drone with a hand lens. Learn about pollinator plants to attract bees to your garden. Bring the kids.
- DEMONSTRATION** on how to make a picture-frame succulent garden. Some already made will be for sale. You will love these after you see how easy they are to make.
- SAVE OUR MONARCHS:** We will be giving away native milkweed plants. These plants are the main food supply for monarch butterflies. Tracy will answer all your questions.
- COMPOSTING/VERMICOMPOSTING:** Instructions for making your own compost bin and learn what to put in it. Learn about **VERMICULTURE** (worms) to make your own fertilizer for your garden. Worms, (red wiggles) may be available for purchase.
