

2023 Price List



We publish this list as a budgetary guide to help as you pray and plan for how you might be a part of the ministry in Guatemala. Whether you are planning a team visit, or would like to provide a 'Hand-Up' to a needy family, we thank you for your consideration.

With 2023 here and prices are increasing across the board from food to construction materials due to Covid-19. We have adjusted the prices accordingly to better accommodate these changes. These prices will go into effect on June, 1st 2023.

If you have an idea or an event that might not fit precisely within one of the categories listed below, please reach out to us. We can often tailor team itineraries and plan special ministry events so that they have the most impact within the local community, while still meeting your budget needs.

Team Hosting, includes all ground transportation, lodging, and food for your visit	
Guatemala City Round Trip, 7-night Itinerary – Guatemala City and Guatemala City	\$825 per person
Guatemala City Round Trip, 7-night Itinerary – Guatemala City and Lake Atitlan or Antigua	\$885 per person
Additional day and night with a visit to Lake Atitlan or Antigua	\$165 per person
Additional small team fee (applies for teams of less than 4 people)	\$220 per person

Relational Ministry Projects and Team Events	
House Visit gift bag including a New Testament in Spanish	\$27.50 per gift bag
House Visit gift bag including a hard-cover complete Bible (Old and New Testaments)	\$33 per gift bag
VBS Event, Typically 70-150 Children Drinks and cookies provided for each child	\$100 per event
Small Group Meeting, Typically 5-15 people for a Bible study or class Drinks and snacks (cookies or chips) provided for each person	\$35 per event
Large Group Meeting, Typically 25-75 youth or adults for a Bible study or class Drinks and snacks provided for each person	\$150 per event

*Tamales are available if you would like to provide a meal. These will be quoted for the specific event.

Construction Projects	
House – 10' x 12' with corrugated steel roof and sides, dirt floor, and a wooden door. Also includes a small wooden table built by the team	\$750 each
Stove – A pre-built metal stove in which the team will install along with proper ventilation out of the roof.	\$450 each
Bunkbed – Complete with mattresses and a small set of shelves. Blankets are optional and extra at \$20 each if the family is in need.	\$450 each

Animal Ministry Projects	
Animal Water Dispenser – To be assembled and provided to a needy family	\$31.25 each
Medium Animal (pig, sheep, goat) for a family, includes vaccinations and some training	\$75 each

Scholarships and 'Hand-Ups'	
Sponsor a Child – Covers school expenses and basic food for the family	\$35 per month
Water Filter – made by Ecofiltro as a social business in Guatemala	\$60 each
