SPOTLIGHT on Board Duties- TREASURER

In each newsletter this summer, we'll be featuring a different board position. Since this is a community pool, we think everyone should know a little bit about what it takes to make this place run!

We're starting with the #1 most essential board position- TREASURER!

Without a treasurer to pay the bills, the pool could not open. Here are just some of the things our treasurer takes care of all year (not just when the pool is open):

- * Paying the property and sales taxes (sales tax on snack bar in the summer & membership dues year-round)
- * Checking the P.O. Box for membership dues and bills
- * Paying the bills (water, electric, cable/internet, & trash)
- * Managing the bank accounts (checking & savings)
- * Processing payments from members
- * Making a budget
- * Processing payroll for employees

I'm sure there's more, but you get the idea. And don't forget- this is a completely unpaid position. Board members get some free guest passes (just like other volunteers do), but they're giving a lot of their time to make sure our pool opens every summer!
