On September 10th, Mandy Oliver, Parker PD's HR Business Partner, shared a staffing update and reviewed the Department's strategy regarding staffing over the past couple of years.

Meeting Summary

- Out of 95 authorized officers, Parker PD currently has 80 positions staffed.
- Five new police officers are graduating from the Police Academy this December.
- Three new officers recently joined the team.
- The Department is proactively tackling the challenges ahead: succession planning and getting officers ready for the Sergeant level.
