RECAP: May 8 COPPS Training Meeting

If you couldn't make it, you missed a great training with CSI Scott Miller Vargas and Officer Josh Cunningham.

CSI Vargas demonstrated the TruNarc handheld narcotics analyzer. It can identify more than 530 controlled substances. (Fortunately, the samples tested in our training were identified as harmless salt and sugar!) He also showed us the FARO camara system. It takes crystal-clear 3D images of crime scenes and we were able to experience a "drive" through a past auto accident scene.

Officer Cunningham showed off several of the department's drones. Each serves a unique function, including one specializing in indoor flight, and one that can be thrown into a situation.. Officer Cunningham shared some drone surveillance footage, showing real life crime fighting on the part of our PPD and their electronic "assistants".

Both presentations were fascinating. We're so thankful for our police and their hi-tech tools that help them do their jobs more safely.
