Their focus is not simply on enforcement, but on ensuring the safety and well-being of everyone in our community.

Report an Issue

An online reporting tool is offered by the Parker Police Department to assist in addressing unsafe and unlawful activities related to electric motorcycles, dirt bikes, and e-bikes in Parker. This tool allows residents to anonymously report locations and details of concerning activities. Individuals who fill out the form will not be contacted by law enforcement. The collected information will contribute to proactive enforcement efforts to enhance community safety.
