Australian Shepherds are very smart dogs. They learn very quickly and flourish when you stimulate their minds. Are you willing to learn how to personally train them or go to a training course to ensure a happy Aussie, and a pet that will thrive with your family? A bored pet that does not receive enough exercise or mental stimulation can cause a lot of destruction. Boredom is the MAIN reason for unwanted behaviors. Are you prepared to invest the time and responsibility required to raise a puppy?:

Are you aware of an Australian Shepherd's grooming needs? Aussies have a double coat and shed year round. If you cannot deal with shedding, an Aussie is not for you. It is recommended to brush them with a special double coat brush, a couple times a week to minimize the amount of shedding and so their coat does not get matted. It can also be very harmful to shave their coats (do your research). Are you willing to keep up with their grooming needs?:

Australian Shepherds are not dogs that are meant to just sit and lounge all day. It is the most important factor in ensuring happy families and happy dogs. Since getting a dog that has a higher drive than you will lead to issues, we want you to choose a puppy that will thrive with your personality and lifestyle.
