An Announcement: "...they shall name him, Emmanuel, which means, 'God Is With Us.'"

The Annunciation, recorded in Luke 1:26-38, is a key event in the story of Jesus' birth. The word "Annunciation" is a special form of the word "announcement." It refers to that holy moment when the angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she

would conceive in her womb and bear a son, the Christ child. Joseph was part of the holy announcement too. The announcement to Joseph is recorded in Matthew 1:18-25. He had found that Mary was already with child and he planned to quietly break-off their engagement. As he slept, his holy moment came as an angel spoke to him while he dreamed.

Just imagine what Mary and Joseph experienced in being called by God to be faithful to God and to one another in this unplanned and unexpected reality of their lives. It must have been a mixture of emotions and experiences for them: the wonder of the unknown: "The power of the Most High will overshadow you," the angel said to Mary; the experience of peace: "Let it be with me according to your word," Mary answered; the acknowledgement of human feelings: "...do not be afraid", the angel said to Joseph.

These are gifts of presence and knowing God shares with us when we are called to follow and serve: a life of wonder in which God's power overshadows us; a life of peace and rest knowing God is in charge and God's will is done as we safely submit to it; a life of being understood for our human condition and loved for who we are, not alone, but with Christ and in Christ, our Savior.

In these seasons of Advent and Christmas, holy moments that announce Christ Jesus is born among us can be found wherever life is lived, fears are set aside, hope is shared and love is given and received where we are. These are God's gifts of wonder and promise to a world so much in need of both. Let us each become announcers of "good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people." Christ Jesus is born! "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors!"

SESSION APPROVED FUNDARISER!



Church Security and Safety

As communicated earlier, a Safety Committee has been formed for Peace Church to focus on multiple security and safety issues. These include emergency weather and fire procedures, staff and volunteer safety, an overall security assessment of the church's facilities, formation of a security team, and the role of firearms (if approved) in protecting the congregation. While a number of these initiatives continue to be worked on, the Safety Committee has recommended, and the session approved, the following firearms policy, which goes into effect immediately.

Peace Church Firearms Policy: Nebraska law prohibits carrying a concealed handgun in a place of worship unless approved by church leadership along with written notice to the congregation. The session of Peace Church has determined NOT to allow concealed handguns on church property. Furthermore, the session has also determined that openly carrying firearms or weapons is prohibited. (These rules do not apply to active-duty law-enforcement officers or off-duty officers being paid by Peace Church for security purposes.) Violations of this policy may result in the offending individual(s) being asked to leave the property and/or placing a call to local law enforcement for further assistance.
