From the Pulpit: "Post-Denominational America"

We live in what many scholars call a "post-denominational" era. By that, they mean that historic denominational ties are not what they once were. Fewer Christians identify with a particular type or brand of their faith. And many, including this author, have be longed to more than one in their lifetimes.

Recently a Presbyterian elder and good friend wrote these thirteen reasons to choose to be, or to remain, a member of a PCUSA congregation. I am condensing his article for you.

- 1. We are a denomination that studies the Bible and tries to discern its meaning for our lives.
- 2. We are a denomination that affirms the Reformation tenet of the priesthood of all believers.
- 3. We corporately and individually confess our individual and collective sins in worship.
- 4. We affirm Philippians 2:12-13, that we must "work out our salvation with fear and trembling."
- 5. We welcome women to positions of authority and ministry at all levels of the church.
- 6. We invite all of God's people into congregational life and leadership.
- 7. We ordain elders and clergy (both men and women) to share equally in providing pastoral services to congregations and the broader church.
- 8. We care deeply about our youth.
- 9. We seek to address social inequalities in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 10. We are a missional church at home and abroad.
- 11. We believe in the connectedness of our congregations as a symbol of the Body of Christ.
- 12. We have a rich history and long held traditions but are continually reforming ourselves.
- 13. We require an educated and trained clergy.

These are some of the key characteristics of the PCUSA of which we are a part. Together they shape our witness to Jesus Christ in the world.


