

Christophe Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques announce their **2024/25 Season championing:**

**Gassmann's farse *L'Opera Seria* at La Scala, Milan
Porpora's *Ifigenia in Aulide* at Bayreuth Baroque Opera
Festival, Lully's *Proserpine* in Versailles, alongside their
first production of Händel's *Orlando* at Paris Châtelet
and the **Sound of Music in Versailles** across US & Canada**



Christophe Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques announce an unmissable **2024-25 season of operatic rediscoveries** including Gassmann's rarely-performed operatic farse *L'Opera Seria* in a new production by **Laurent Pelly** for their eagerly-awaited return to **La Scala** in the **spring of 2025**. As resident artists at the **Bayreuth Baroque Opera Festival** in **September**, Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques present the modern premiere of Porpora's *Ifigenia in Aulide* in a new production by **Max Emanuel Cenčić**.

Rousset was awarded the 2024 Händel Prize in Halle. As such, further unmissable highlights will include their first *Orlando* by Händel in a new production by **Jeanne Desoubeaux** at the Châtelet in **January** and a revival of Damiano Michieletto's production of Händel's *Giulio Cesare in Egitto* in Toulouse in **February**. They will return to the Opera Royal in Versailles with *Proserpine*, which will be their penultimate recording of the complete Lully operas. Following



their moving performance of St Matthew Passion 2 years ago, Les Talens Lyriques are reunited with **Anna El Khashem** and **Mari Askvik** for **Bach's Easter Oratorio** in Grenoble, Lucerne, Aix-en-Provence, Paris and Metz. More irresistible delights include a floral-inspired residency at the **Château of Chantilly** and a major tour of **North America** to San Francisco, L.A., San Diego, Tucson and Montreal. The 2024-25 season is a glorious celebration of ancient myths and tales.

As Rousset explains:

"As a child, I used the excuse of going to bed early so that I could read the magical legends from the ancient world into the small hours. Later I studied ancient Greek and Latin to explore Hesiod's Theogony, Homer's Iliad and Ovid's Metamorphoses in the original. I never imagined that one day I would be able to bring these stories of gods and goddesses, half-god heroes, sacrifices, oracles and magical transformations to life on the stage. As enchanting as they are evocative, these tales provided an inexhaustible source of inspiration for operatic composers - the Baroque world's equivalent of the Hollywood blockbusters. Prepare for joy, lust, tragedy, theatrical antics, royal flurries and seductively-scented evenings."



Les Talens Lyriques' September residency at Bayreuth Baroque Opera Festival begins with a new production of Porpora's *Ifigenia in Aulide* (**5-15 September**) directed by **Max Emanuel Cenčić** who also sings the role of Agamennone. Some 30 years ago, Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques created the soundtrack to the film *Farinelli* on which Porpora's aria *Alto Giove* from *Polifemo* became one of their all-time bestsellers.

While in Bayreuth, **Sandrine Piau** joins for *Aroma di Roma*, an evening of arias by Scarlatti, Händel and Montéclair and **Anna Prohaska** for *Oper in Hamburg* with arias by Handel, Keiser, Mattheson, Telemann and Graupner.

Following a return to **Ambronay Festival** on **4 October** with a programme of Bach alto arias with **Paul Figuer** - and later with **Zoltán Darago** in **Paris Salle Cortot** in December -, Les Talens Lyriques celebrate the last blooms before winter and the planting of bulbs for the coming spring over a floral-inspired weekend at the **Château de Chantilly** with three scented programmes. They commence with **Ambroisine Bré** and **Nahuel di Pierro** singing Händel's Cantata *Apollo e Dafne* - the legend of the transformation of Daphne into a tree captured so evocatively in Bellini's famous statue in Rome. After a morning concert of harpsichord duets with Rousset and **Korneel Bernolet**, Bré and Pierro return for a programme of Royer and Rameau, featuring the famous Entrée "Les Fleurs, Fête persane" from *Les Indes Galantes*.

Ambroisine Bré again joins Les Talens Lyriques for their **North American tour with "The Sound of Music in Versailles"** beginning in San Francisco on **12 November** and ending in Canada in Montréal. The programme celebrates the operatic wonders of Lully and Montéclair as well as the chamber music of Couperin.

The New Year sees Les Talens Lyriques turn to Händel for their first **Orlando** in a new production by **Jeanne Desoubeaux** at the Châtelet with a stunning cast including **Katarina Bradić, Siobhan Stagg, Elizabeth DeShong, Giulia Semenzato** and **Riccardo Novaro** running from **23 January to 2 February**. Then Elizabeth DeShong

joins them in the title role of **Giulio Cesare in Egitto** in Toulouse from **21 February to 2 March** in a revival of Damiano Michieletto's production.

Following their critically-acclaimed debut at **La Scala** with Cavalli's *Calisto* 3 years ago, Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques have been reinvented to Milan for their first collaboration with **Laurent Pelly** championing **Gassmann's comedy L'Opera Seria** from **29 March to 9 April**. This operatic farce follows impresario - Fallito - having to contend with the conflicting histrionics of composer - Ritornello, librettist - Delirio, prima donna - Stonatrilla, ballet master - Passagallo, and all manner of other characters including the singers' mothers, in his attempt to mount a new opera - enough to drive anyone to distraction, let alone bankruptcy. Rousset has long tried to collaborate with Laurent Pelly but dates had never clicked and finally this dream has come true in Milan. On **18 May** in Milan, and **25 May** in Paris TCE, they will give a concert performance of Mozart's **Mitridate** - in the first of three performances of Mozart's early operas composed for Milan which will continue in subsequent seasons.

As Rousset and Les Talens Lyriques approach the end of their Lully opera odyssey, they are joined by a stunning cast including **Véronique Gens, Marie Lys, Ambroisine Bré, Nick Pritchard** for **Proserpine** at the Opera Royal in Versailles on **15 June** and at the Theater an der Wien on **17 June 2025**.

Nick Pritchard and **Edwin Crossley-Mercer** also join the cast with **Anna El Khashem** and **Mari Askvik** for **Bach's joyous Easter Oratorio** in Grenoble (**16th April**), Lucerne (**18th April**), Aix-en-Provence Easter Festival (**20 April**), Paris Philharmonie (**21 April**) and Metz on **26 April**.

2024-25 presents a season of tantalising vocal delights, both rarities and well-loved favourites from the world of the baroque.


